 - › Leverage investments and promote joint actions

 - › Organisations



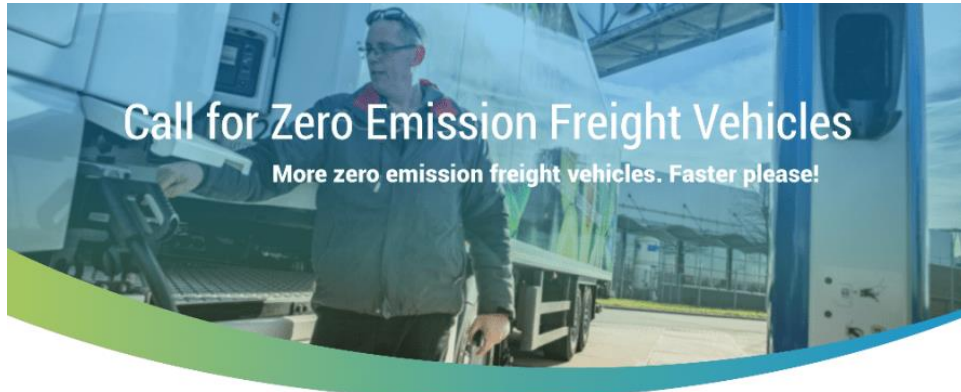
Fossil Fuel Free Streets Declaration
