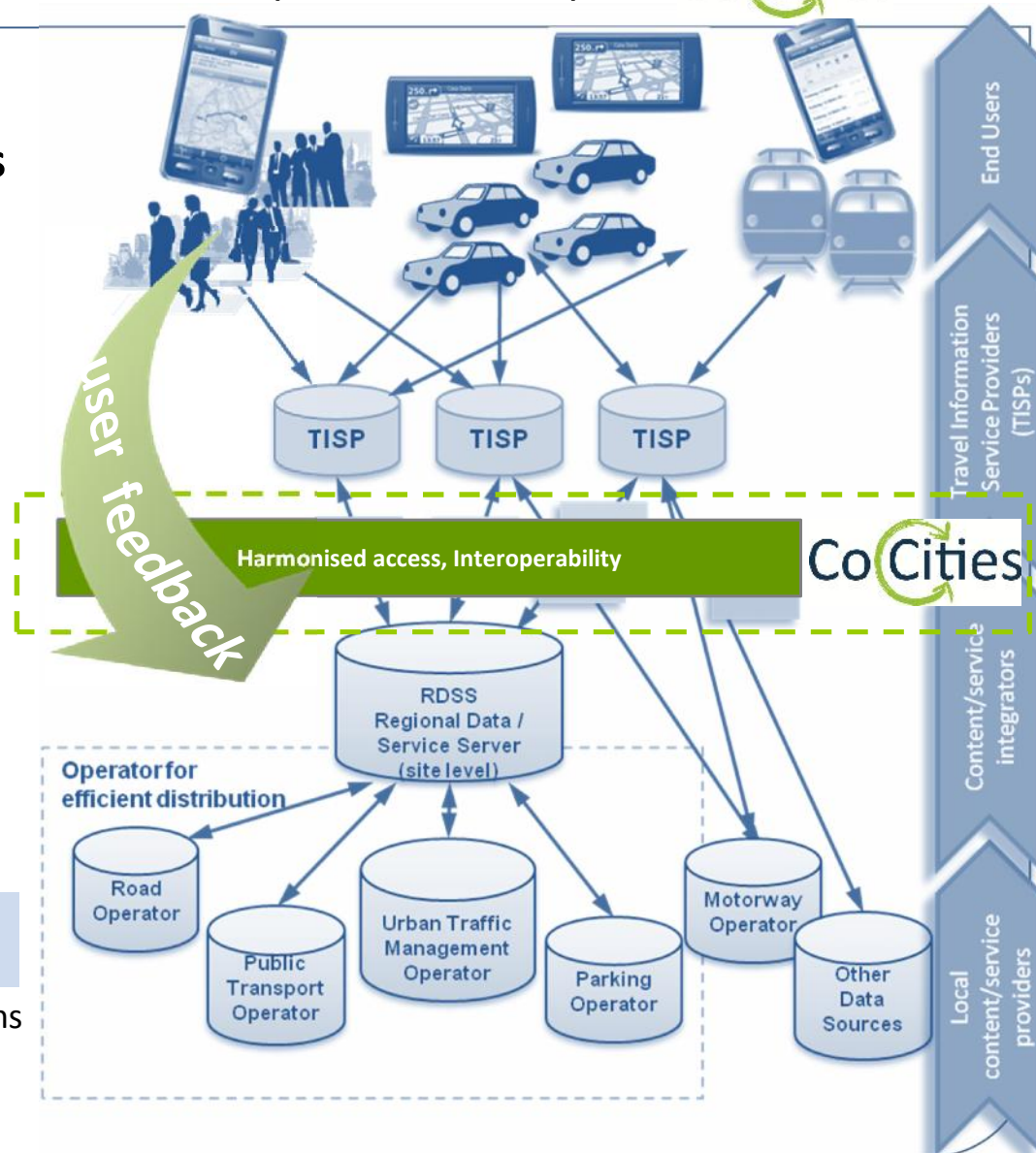

## Adding user feedback services

- Cooperative Mobility
  - ⇒ information / validation of services
- End-user devices
  - ⇒ In-vehicle
  - ⇒ hand-held (i.e. PNDs, smartphones)
- Validated by Local Authorities
  - ⇒ Feedback processing
- Evaluation of cooperative mobility services
  - ⇒ impacts, options, ...
- Piloting in 6 EU sites
  - ⇒ Vienna, Treviso, Tuscany Region, Bilbao, Brno, Reading
  - ⇒ roadmap for EU cities and regions
  - ⇒ **Madrid, Bolzano joined**

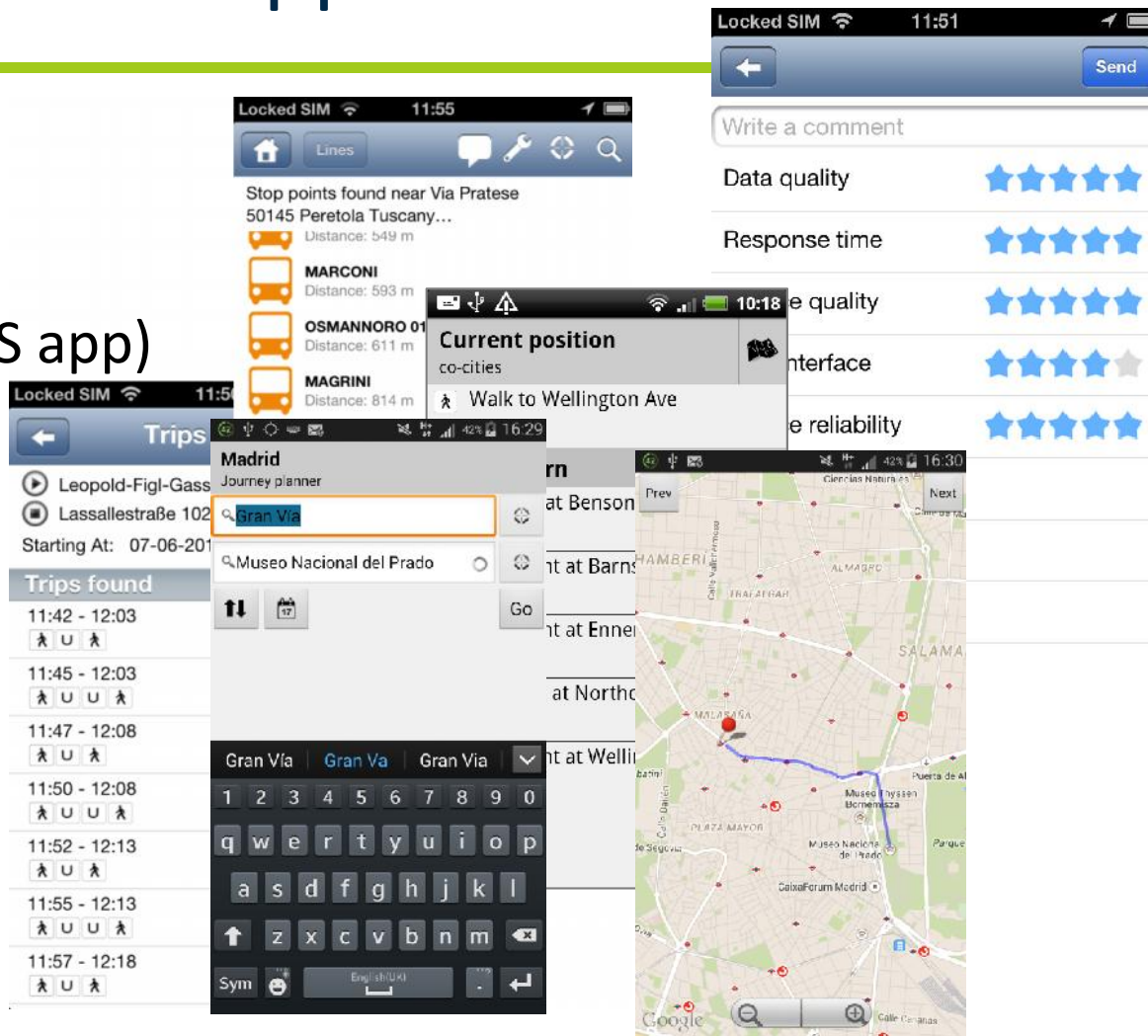
