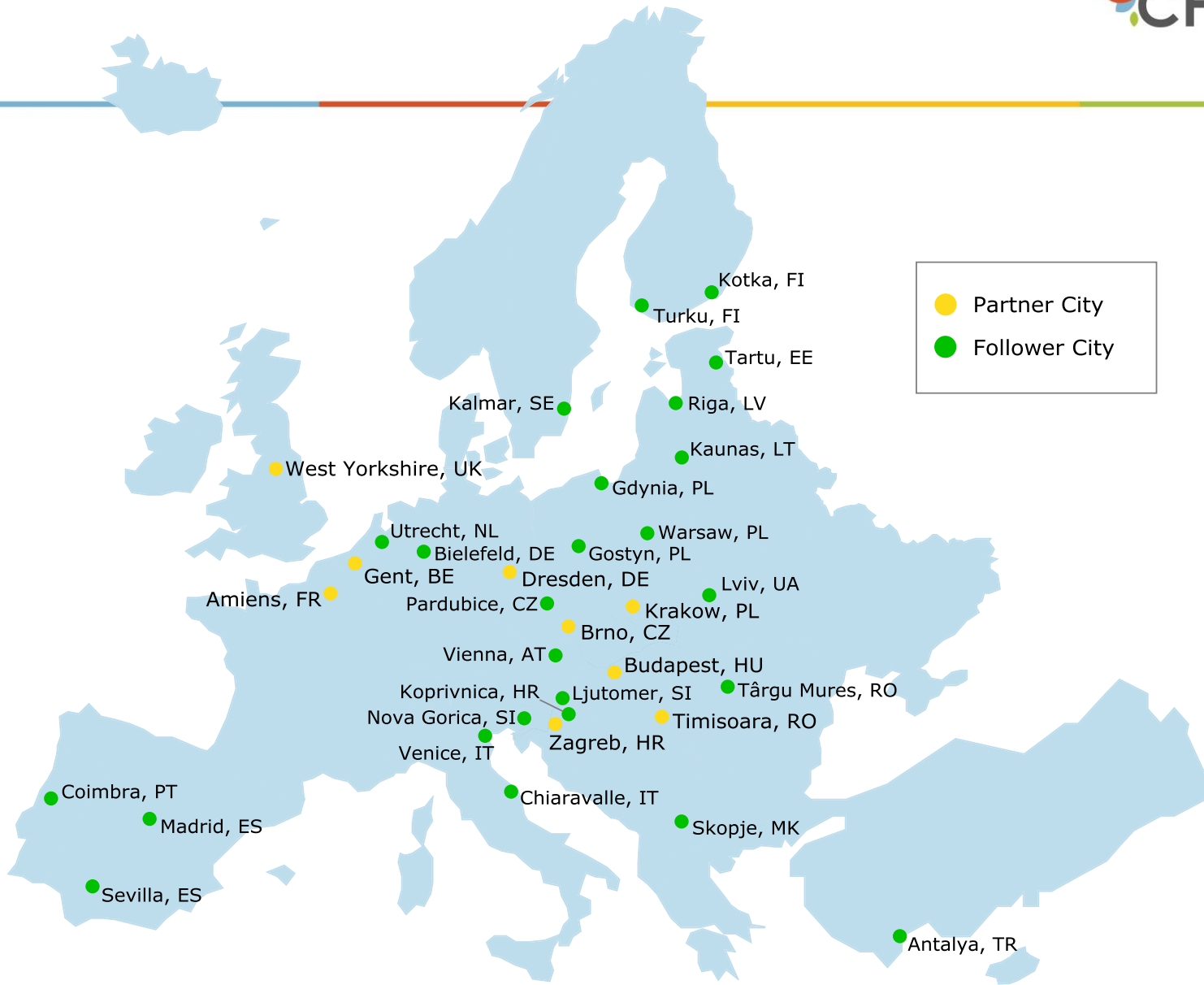

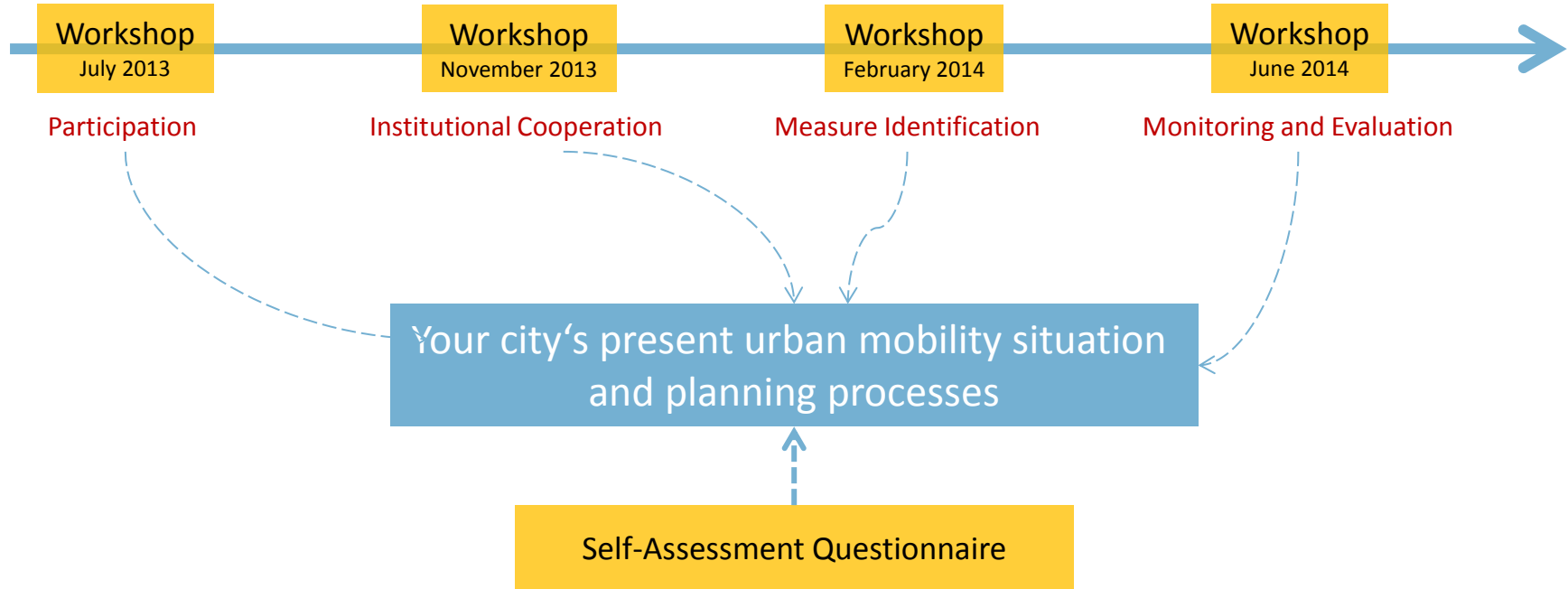
Overview of Follower Cities

Road Map Development



- SUMP Expert Team: Institute for Transport Studies Leeds, Rupperecht Consult, Urban Institute of the Republic of Slovenia
- Road Map concept is currently being developed

- Four e-learning courses will be developed in the CH4ALLENGE project
- They will deal with one SUMP challenge each and will provide information on how to overcome the four challenges when developing a SUMP
- The courses will be based on self-learning modules so participants can follow the courses at their own pace
- The e-learning courses will be made available free of charge on the CH4ALLENGE website and are open to all follower cities
- E-learning courses will be online in early 2015

National SUMP Challenge Seminars:

- Aim: to specifically link into the local (national) context and legislation, to stimulate other cities to follow the footsteps of the CHALLENGE cities
- Focus on New Member States; organised in local language
- These are open to all interested (follower) cities of the country where the seminar takes place
- Travel costs would have to be covered by your municipality
