# March 21, 2013

- Decree: terms and conditions of use of the reserved on-street parking spaces
- Regulate the car sharing market : open model with accreditations

# July 18, 2013

- Decree: regulatory aspects of the Regional Parking Policy Plan
  - Communal Parking Action
    Plan = strategic planning
    tool at the municipality scale



# June 1, 2016

The decree is modified to allow free-floating car sharing

# Missions parking.brussels

- Provide regional parking permits for 25€/year/vehicle
- Approve and review Car sharing Action Plans of the 19 municipalities
- Prepare the **annual report** based on operational data and users survey



#### **ACTIONS:** 6 ACCREDITATIONS



#### Accreditations and regional parking permits

- 6 accreditations approved
- 1.214 regional parking permits delivered
- Free parking everywhere excepted in high rotation zones (red and orange zones)
- Fully digitalized management and control of the parking permits with aid of the software of parking.brussels




#### Car sharing Action Plans

- Inventory and diagnosis of the existing car sharing stations
- Phased development scenario respecting 2 goals :
  - Growth: 800 reserved parking spaces in 2020 regarding population size of municipalities
  - Dispersion: maximum average score regarding accessibility zones A, B and C
- 16 out of 19 municipalities have an approved plan
- Planned locations are shared between operators according to their demands

#### **ACTIONS: REPORTS**





#### > Annual report based on operational data and users survey

- Three annual reports published with support from operators (2015, 2016, 2017)
- One on going promotion campaign with Brussels Region (September 2018)
- Actions with encouraging results!





#### DISPERSION





#### WHAT ABOUT PARKING POLICY?



- Encouraging results, but what about parking policy?
  - One indicator: a private car is 15 to 3,5 times less used than a shared car

Non-use	Station-based	Free-floating	Private
average time	shared car	shared car	car
	69,7%	92,8%	97,9%

One approach (to consider with all the necessary precautions):

Up to car sharing surveys:

32% customers have sold a car thanks to the presence of a car sharing solution

25% customers would (probably) have purchased a car if this car sharing solution didn't exist

7.802 less cars

670 shared vehicles

Ratio: 1 shared car replaces 12,6 private cars!


- Decree laying down an approval regulation for car sharing systems between privates individuals
- 1st accreditation for Cozycar platform in June 2018

# Free floating bike sharing

- Draft decree on the license for operators in progress
- Needs a deep reflection on conditions of accreditation and parking solutions



- July 28<sup>th</sup> 2017 : decree laying down an approval regulation for car sharing systems between privates individuals
  - First accreditation for Cozycar car sharing platform in June 2018
  - No regional parking permits → Challenge of providing parking permits to multiple users of the same car in the context of sectorization project :





"geographical areas centered on the residence place which delimit the streets on which the parking permit is valid"



# Draft decree on the license for operators of free-floating bike sharing in progress

- A lot of operators interested in Brussels market (>1000 bikes in 2017)
- Public administration need a deep reflection on conditions of accreditation
- Public administration need a deep reflection on parking solutions ...





# Regional parking policy as an enabler for car sharing?

- Historical support from Brussels Region to first operators
- Car sharing defined as a strong measure to fight on-street parking problems in strategical planning documents
- Establishment of a regulatory framework accompanied by encouraging results
- Controlled opening to new models of car sharing!
