






Procurement of P-T-Services in North-Brabant


Incorporation zero emission goals

- Market consultation (risks: costs, certainty of bids)
- Real expextations




Procurement of P-T-Services in North-Brabant

- No completety new fleet at start
- Procurement points for zero-emission e-buses at the start of the contract
- Points for a clear vision on the zero emission transition
- Use pilotbuses mandatory
- Coöperation transition mandatory
- PTA accountable extra budgets pilots




PTA's as Launching Customer: Pilots in current contracts





Results Nationwide-North-Brabant

- Technical pilots (Ebusz- Fuelcell A'dam, 220Xpress, IPT)
- Contract (Schiermonnikoog 6, Schiphol 35, Utrecht 3, PNB? – dec 2013)
- Start ups (North-Brabant, SRE, Arnhem-Nijmegen, Limburg, upcoming procurements)
- Instruments (models: TCO-ZEB, Green Cockpit; Cleantechfund: InnoBV)



Lessons Learned

- Involvement of transitionmanager at start procurement
- Riskmanagement important (TCO as tool)
- Pilots & procurement do not match easily
- PTA's can operate as launching customer
- Combining economic & sustainability goals is challenging & demanding
- Range important factor introducing e-busses (efficient operations)
