






# parking plan - WHY?

not an end in itself, but **leverage** for better mobility







# parking plan - HOW?

#### off-street

- parking garages split into longterm parkings & rotation parkings
- new P+R areas at outskirts
- parking ratios in new developments (adapted to onstreet parking tariffs)

#### on-street

- more parking space for bicycles
- priority for residents
- larger paid parking area
- the closer to the centre, the higher the cost





# innovation policy - WHY?

### steering

- bullying with policy measures
- better enforcement and monitoring of policy

more efficient management, cost reduction

### policy measures:

parking mediator, promoting car sharing, living streets,...
