About the MORE Project

The EU-funded MORE project is developing procedures and tools for the design of major urban radial routes, connecting to national road networks – addressing both current and future conditions. MORE will test these on corridors in five 'urban nodes' of the Trans-European Transport Network (Budapest, Constanta, Lisbon, London and Malmö) and will deliver tools to assist cities in their road space re-design processes. Specifically, the MORE project will develop four tools:

- A library with suggested design elements, to develop new options for street-space allocation that meet specified policy objectives;
- A stakeholder engagement tool for the co-creation of design options, using both webbased and traditional planning tools;
- A traffic simulation tool that will mimic user behaviour in streets and on roads, and assess aggregate behaviour in terms of a set of performance indicators;
- An appraisal tool for the assessment of the resulting design options.

The MORE Exchange Forum

The MORE Exchange Forum is a platform to <u>discuss and exchange ideas relating to road/street-space allocation on main roads in cities (including kerbside management) and to provide feedback on the MORE tools and research results. Members of the MORE Exchange Forum will receive frequent updates, have the opportunity to meet regularly throughout the project and contribute to shape the MORE tools and concepts.</u>

MORE Exchange Forum Members will be able to closely follow, comment on and validate the development of the tools. They will also serve as a sounding board for discussing other areas of work in the MORE project, where user needs are identified, regulatory frameworks are reviewed, technological futures are explored and scenarios are developed, and dynamic road design requirements are identified; and to share their own work.
