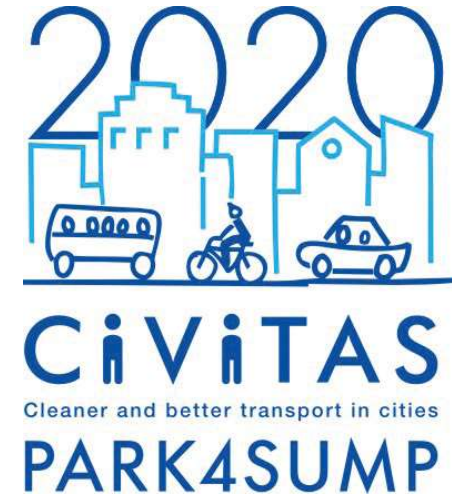


Parking Policies and measures to drive new mobility services

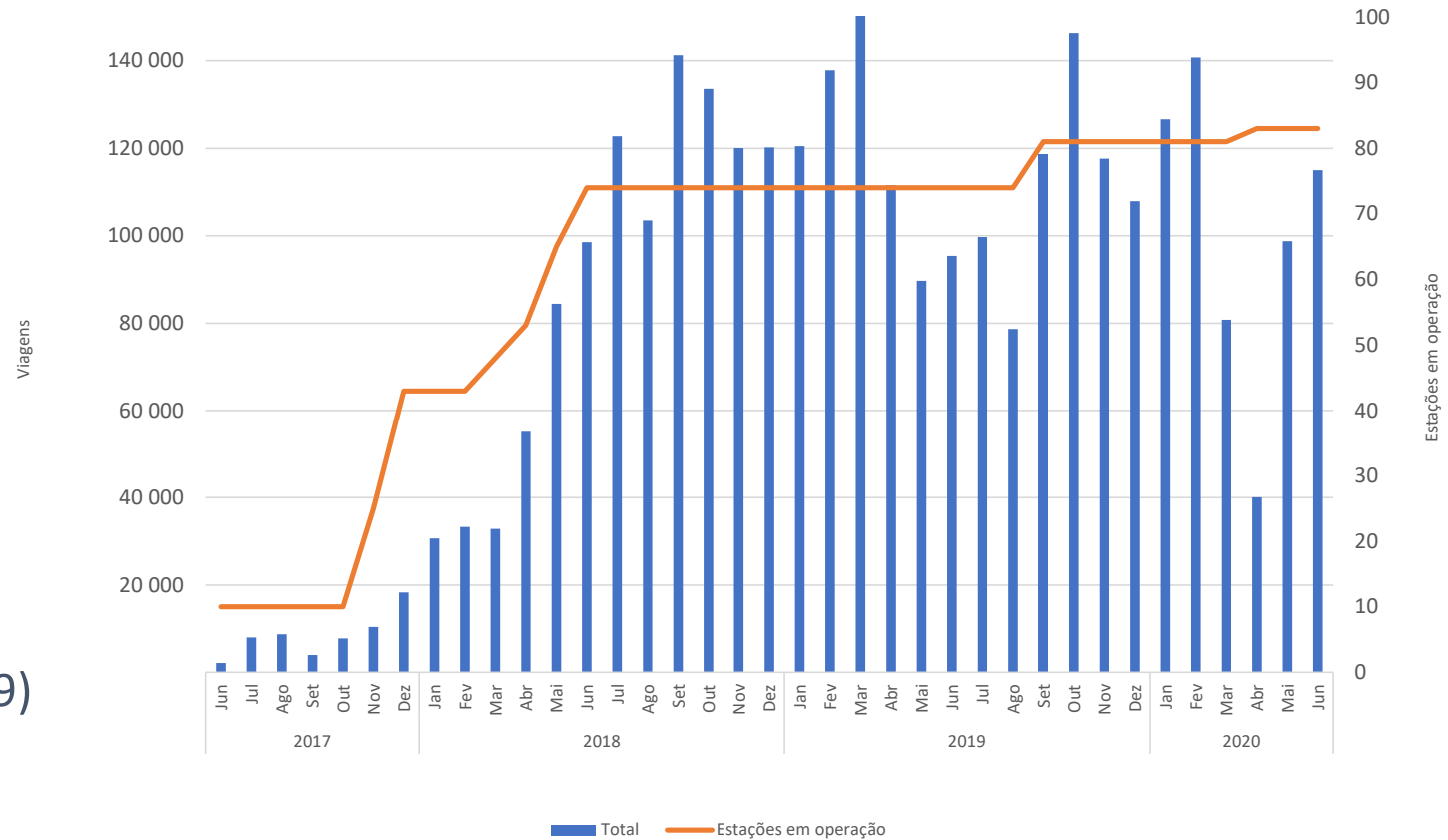

BIKE SHARING IN LISBON

- 1.440 bikes (60% electric)
- 140 Bike stations
- Over 3,1 Milhões Trips
- 15 mil Annual subscribers
- 7,7 trips / day / bicicleta (2019)

BIKE SHARING USE EVOLUTION







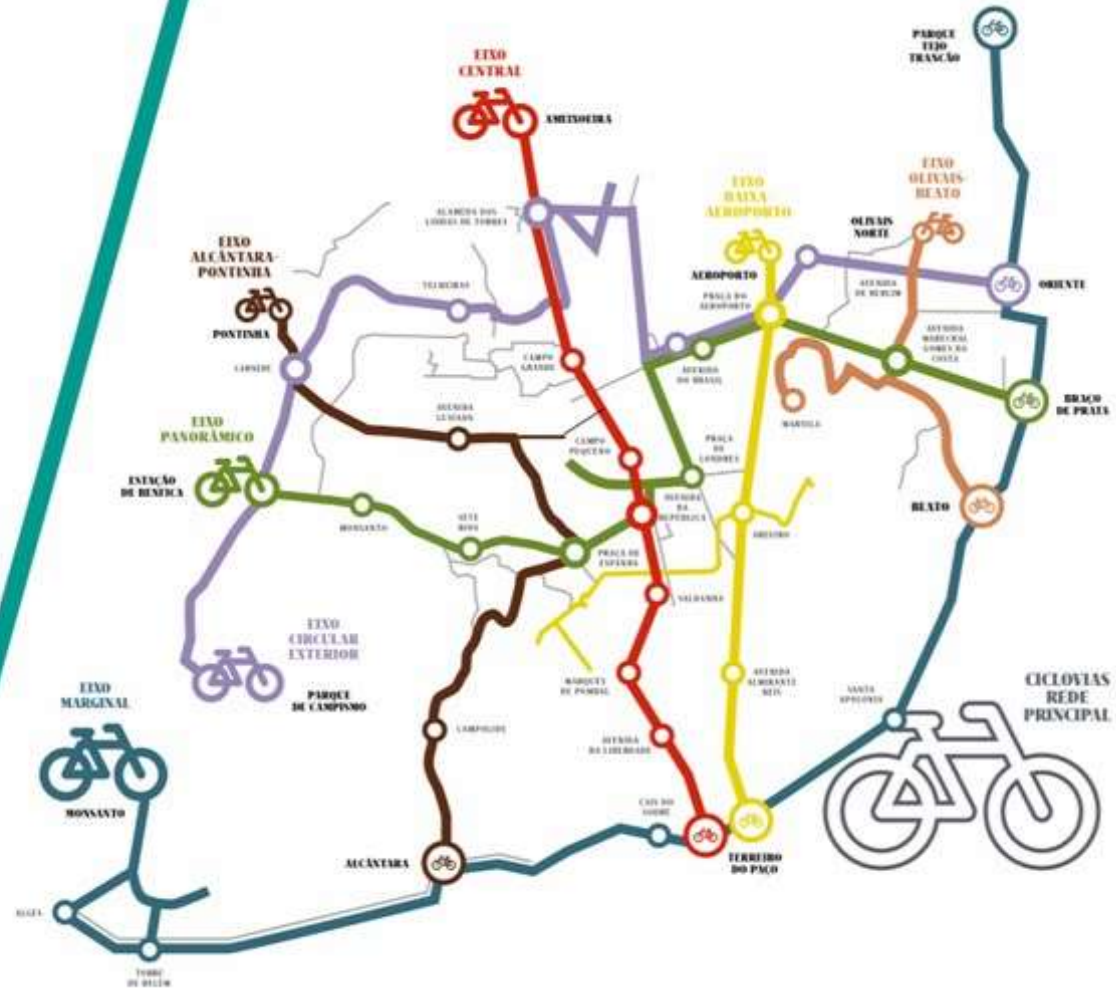
Bike lanes (r)evolution in 3 years...


- From 40 Km (in 2018)
- To 120 Km (in 2020)
- Target > **200 Km** (in 2021)

During COVID confinement period
(March to July 2020) the network
was increased by 20 Km
