IMPACT OF COVID-19

- Full online education (by start of corona)
- 30% fysiek en 70% online juni
- Agreement between public and private institutions on adjusting schedules

Start before 7.30: health care

sector

Start before 8.30 or after 9.30:

office workers

Start between 8.30 - 9.30:

education

- 8.30: secundary education
- 8.30-9.00: vocational colle
- 9.00-9.30: university (for applied sciences)
