• Accessibility – doing the right thing:






Observations: city center development

- Functions changing place to buy → place to be
- More density : shopping ⇒ living working leasure
- Prevalence pedestarian : walking (& bycicle) → priority(!)
- Importance public transport : ⇒ station, train, bus
- Agening : more people get older → new demands

- Fysical disabilities
- Aids (wheelchairs walkers etc.)
- Senses (eyesight, hearing ...)
- Speed ... Balance
- Orientation ...Cognitive

2040


- 18 million inhabitants
