design for all

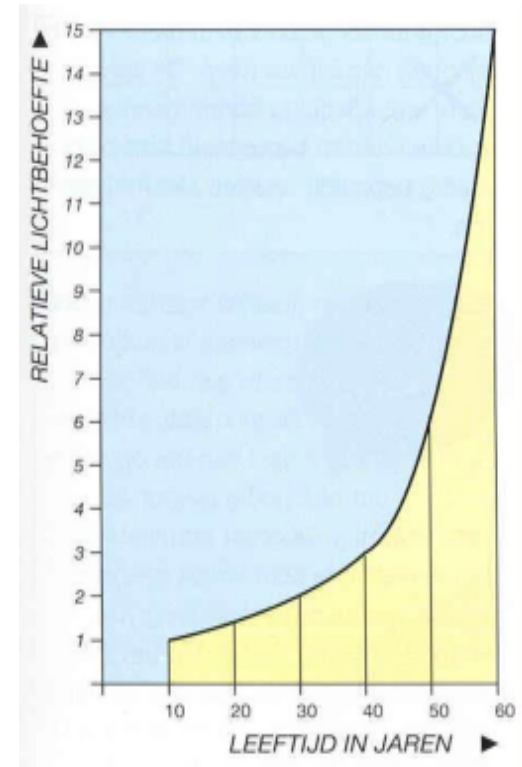


# Observations: city center development

- Functions changing – place to buy ➡ place to be
- More density : shopping ➡ living – working - leisure
- Prevalence pedestrian : walking (& bicycle) ➡ priority(!)
- Importance public transport : ➡ station, train, bus
- Ageing : more people get older ➡ new demands

# Agening ...

- Fysical disabilities
- Aids (wheelchairs – walkers etc.)
- Senses (eyesight, hearing ...)
- Speed ... Balance
- Orientation ...Cognitive

# Ageing in The Netherlands

2040

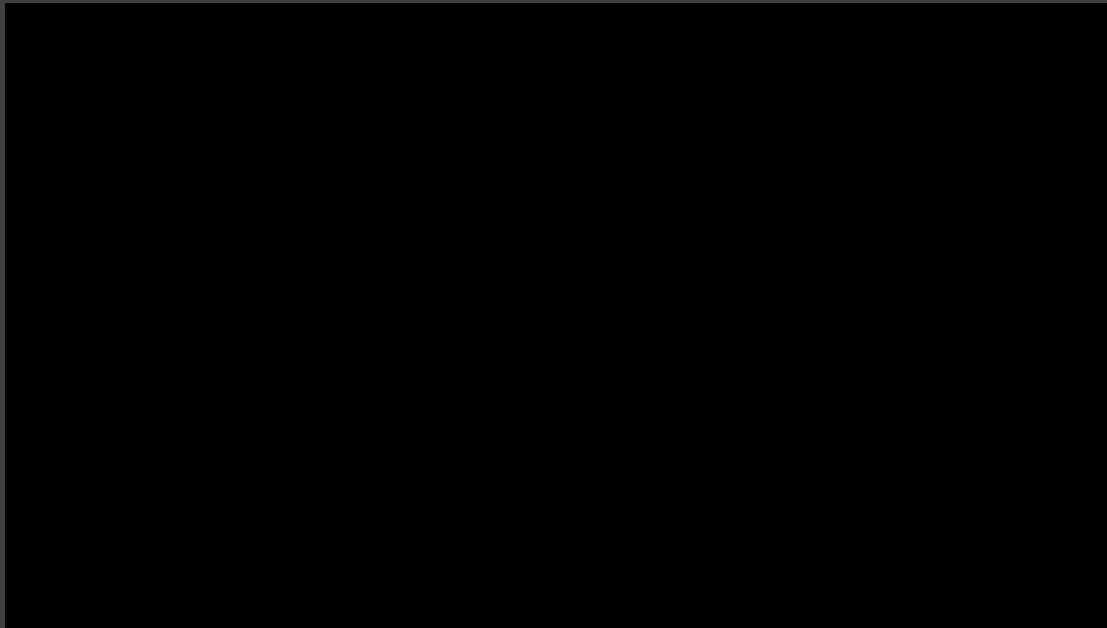
- 18 million inhabitants
- 4,7 million >65 yr / 1,5 million 80+ yr
- 26 % > 65 yr / 1 in 12 > 80 yr
- Station → very important transfer point

### **Design for all ...**

- **Design for a 85 year old (and for a 3 year old)**
- **If it suits them; it suits everyone**
- **Make wide space, even and flat surface  
and enough light / contrast**
- **Think of resting places (furniture)**
- **Try to make "way finding" - *intuitive***
