






Mobility demand during the pandemic

1. FOCUS ON THE SERVICE

Measures for administrative employees and service team worldwide Define cleaning standards for offering the safest experience to users


2. COMMUNICATE WITH CITIES

Establish a dialogue with municipalities, public transport operators, stakeholders

Immediate execution of the directives of each country

3. PROPOSE SOLUTIONS

Proactively propose different models of cooperation



Bike sharing is individual public transport: Germany Case

BERLIN

+ only 36% fewer trips than in the same month of 2019

AUGSBURG

- + 20% Bikes
- + Extra Stations (virtual stations next to hospitals, fire stations and police stations)
- = almost doubled the total number of trips compared to the previous month
- = 42% more registrations on average than in the same month of 2019

LEVERKUSEN

- + Extra Stations (virtual stations next to hospitals and police stations)
- = 39% more trips than in the previous month
- = 26% more registrations on average than in the same month of 2019

The first 30 min at Berlin's nextbike bike-sharing scheme become free

SWANSEA

+ Swansea University supplied hunderts of 3month free vouchers for students

GLASGOW

+ Corona Vouchers: Thanks to Glasgow City Council and Transport Scotland, the first 30 minutes of each rental were made free until Spring 2021

MILTON KEYNES

+ Santander bike share scheme reopened offering the first 30 minutes of every ride for free for 3 months

Highest rentals return in Swansea after Covid shutdown



Nextbike makes record-breaking rentals return in Swansea after three-month Covid shutdown

Scotland's two largest cities to benefit from free bike-share services

Temporary free access to bike-share services in Glasgow and Edinburgh has been put in place as COVID-19 lockdown measures ease.



Bike sharing is individual public transport: Slovakia Case

Arriva bike is coming back to Nitra

ZILINA & NITRA

- + At the beginning, bike was not considered as a safe vehicle, so system was shut down
- + New season started in may with the bike disinfection on a daily basis
- + Importance of face mask and gloves usage was communicated to all bike users
- + Currently, bikes are being proactively hired again (ca. 30.000 rentals per month per 100 active bikes)





Bike sharing is individual public transport: Spain Case

LAS PALMAS

- + nextbike's local system *Sitycleta* stayed open throughout the pandemic
- + Sitycleta was enlarged by adding more ebikes and stations to connect the flat and the hilly parts of the city as well as to improve and scale the bicycle lane network



Key learnings

- Active mobility is the **best complement for public tra**nsport in our cities
- Bike share is individual public transport
- Public subsidies via public transport integration enhance bike-sharing systems' performance and help to keep cities and citizens moving
- Appropriate public & private partnerships are essential to schemes' post-corona virus recovery, e.g. offsetting the movement of people back into their cars through new cycling infrastructure and workplace storage/shower facilities; reducing fears of shared equipment; improving the seamless mobility offer and digitizing the booking experience
