













EIT Urban Mobility accelerates the transition to more liveable urban spaces



EIT Crisis Response Initiative

Exceptional COVID-19 Crisis Response Call

- Allocation of nearly €5 million
- Close to 100 applications
- 11 COVID response innovation projects
- From call to demo in only 6 months
- COVID Accelerator program supporting 23 startups.
- Most of the Covid response projects focus on supporting shared mobility, helping vulnerable people access mobility services despite the pandemic, and hygiene measures to maintain confidence in public transport.
