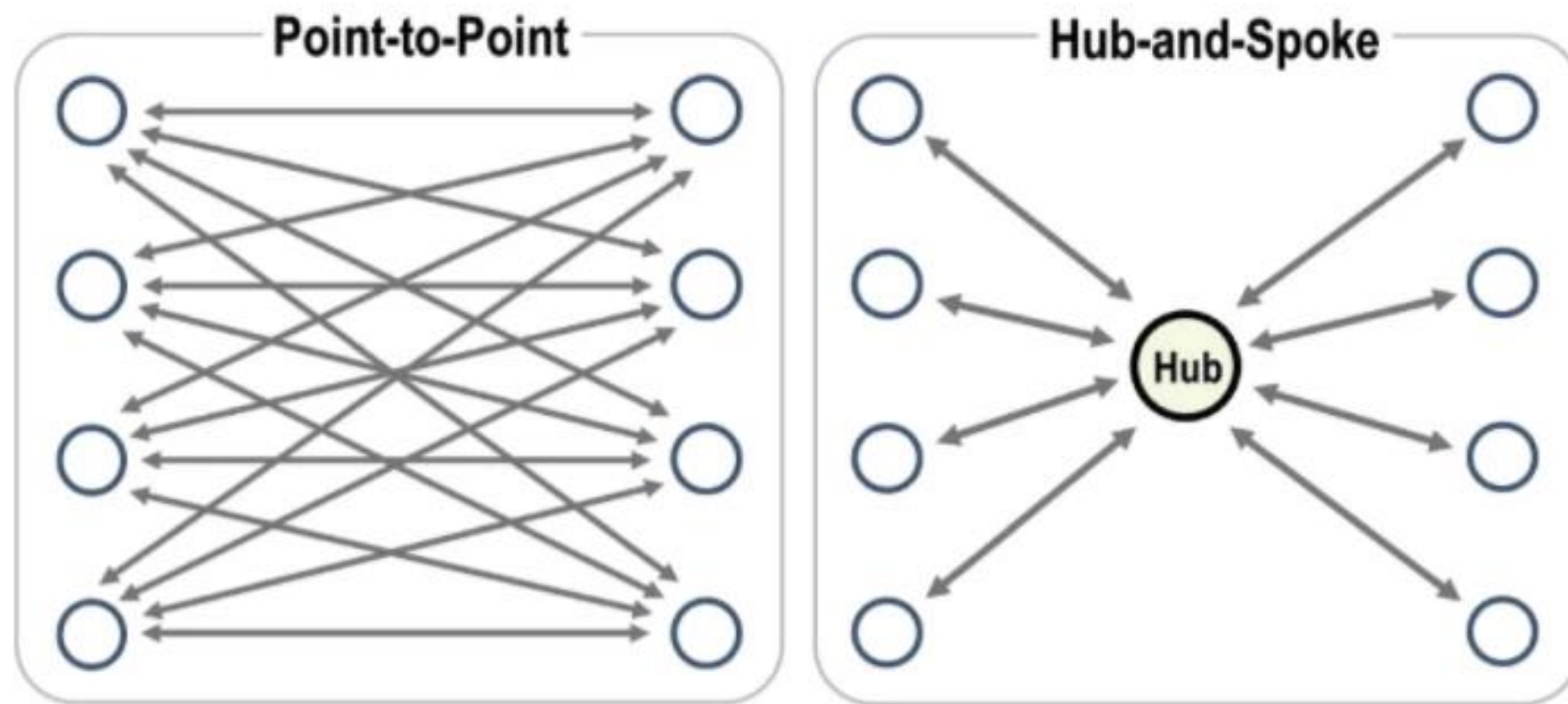

*We know that women's transport needs different so why do we need this session?*





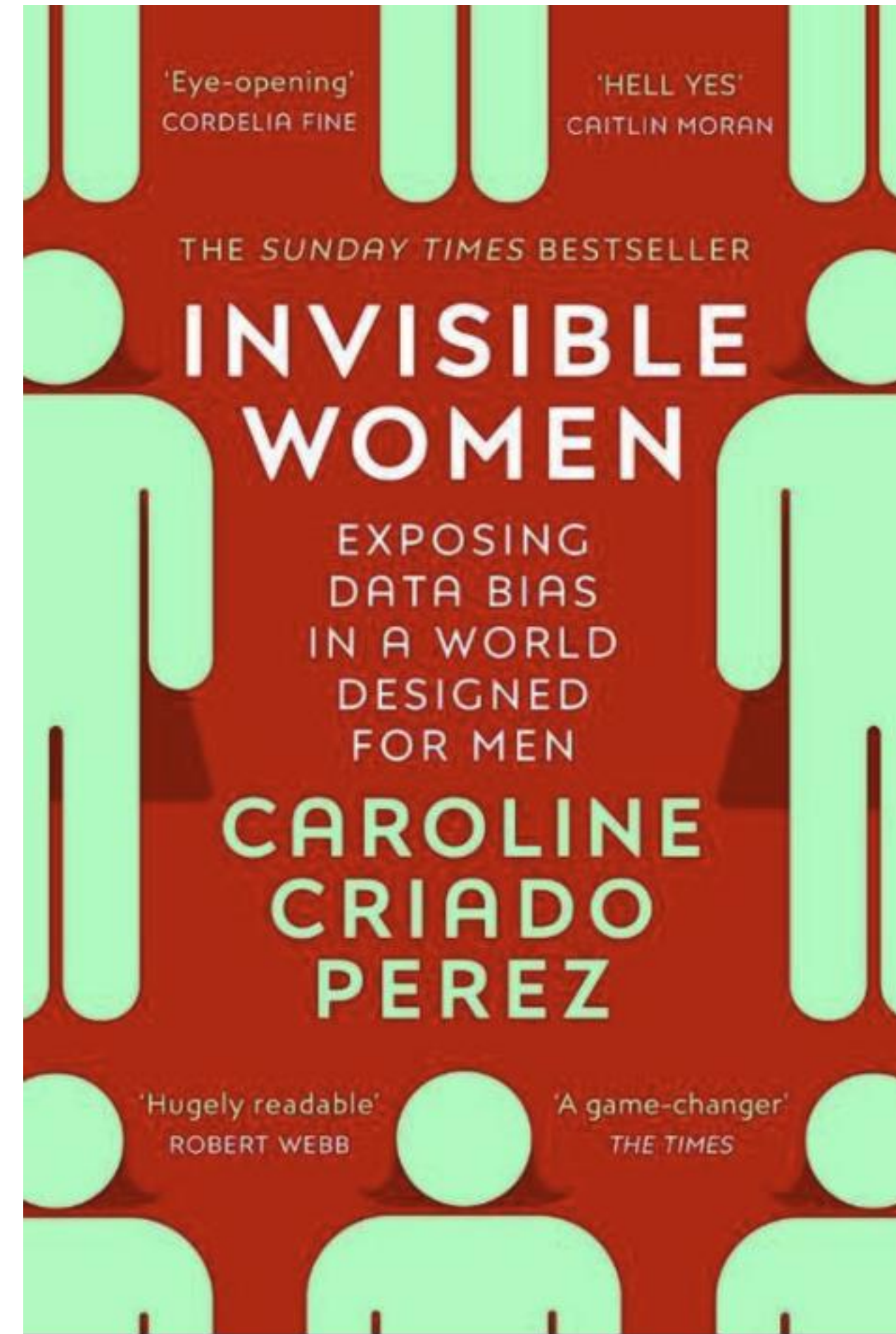
*Lots of short trips out of peak hours – right?*

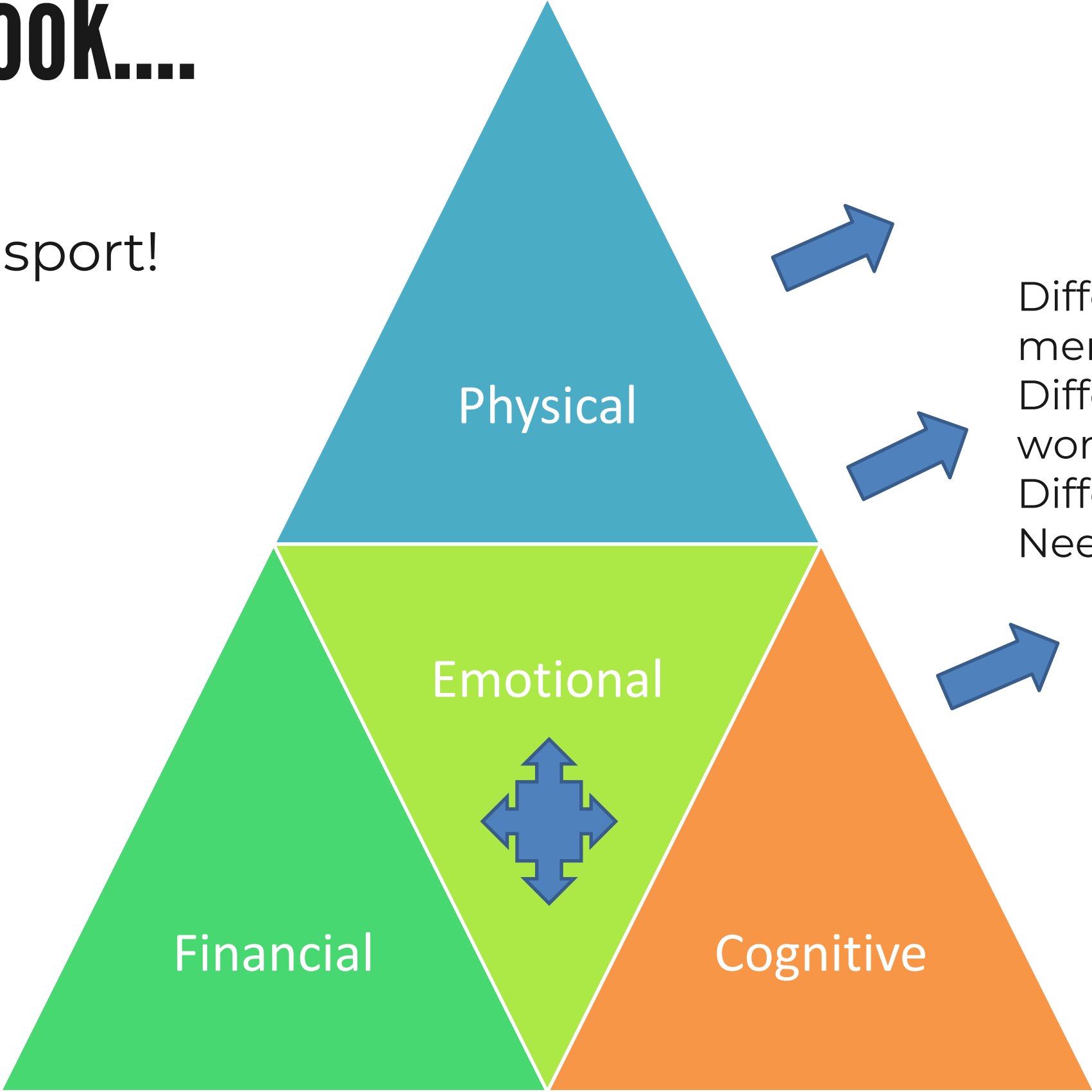

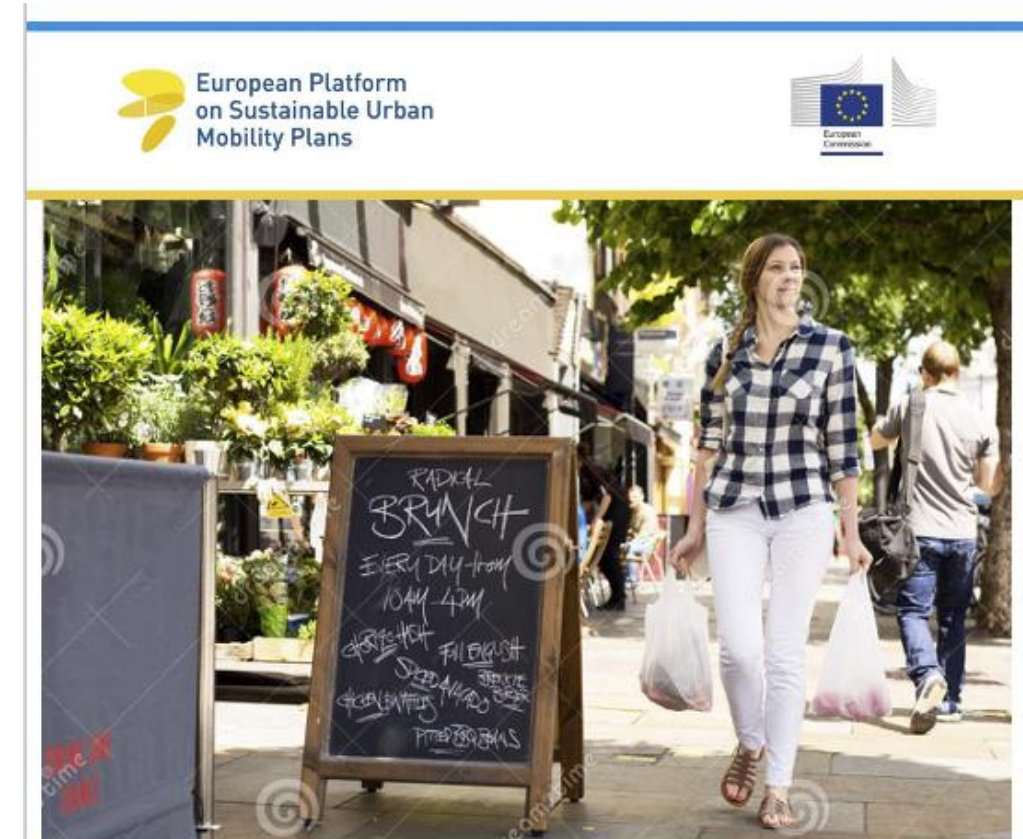
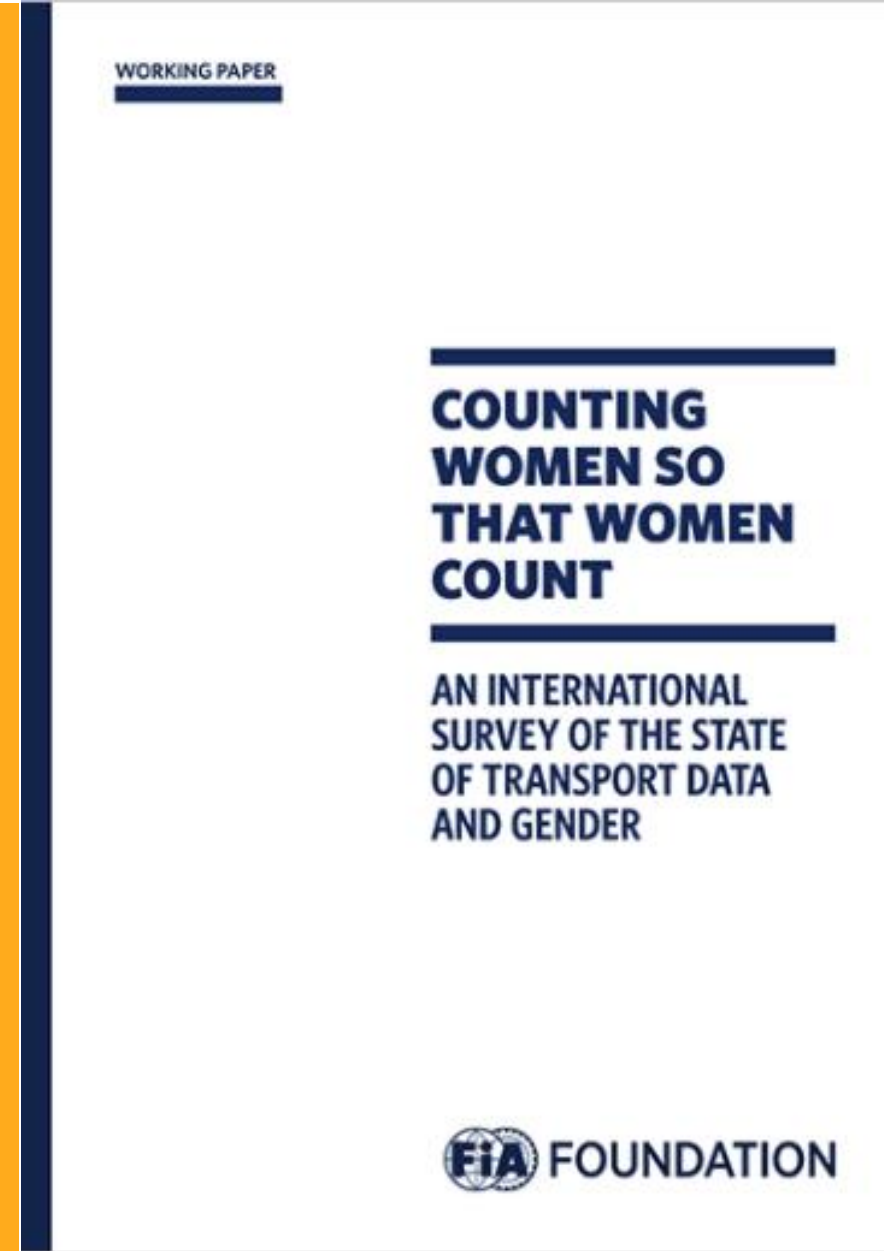
