










Fundamental solution for PT funding needed


EU funds for electrification + digitalization: fragmented and/or PT authorities depend on member state level decisions



Preliminary takeaways

- Vaccination increases trust
- Understand users' source of concerns, segment typologies
- New lifestyle & habits: structural 90% patronage wrt pre-COVID-19
 - New business/financing models
 - Opportunity to integrate multimodal & on-demand solutions
- Consistent & convincing campaigns for PT
- EU funding available but need for dialogue with EU and Nat Govs on how to change funding mechanisms in LT
- Holistic view of PTAs / local authorities is key
 - Access regulation, pricing, charging infrastructure, soft modes, etc.
