



Extending the public transport network



- With buses, trains and trams as a backbone in the public transport network, shared micromobility extends the network and makes it more accessible.
- An affordable and sustainable way to expand the transport network. An e-scooter trip in Stockholm has lower emissions than the average passenger kilometer with a bus in the public transport network, shows our research.
- Shared micromobility helps offload buses, trains and trams supporting social distancing as a result of COVID-19. Together we grow the availability of sustainable transport modes, which helps reverse dependency of cars.





Social pricing models

Some amenities, such as transportation and mobility services are not affordable to all.

Voi is for everyone

At Voi we believe that everyone should be able to ride with us.

We have therefore created three types of discounts on our passes for different parts of society, below is a brief summary of our discounts and you can find a link to our application form further down this page.













VOI 4 HEROES

We are supporting NHS and Emergency Service workers with free access to Voi until the end of this third, national lockdown. That's right, 100% off our Voi Pass (normally 75% off).

What is accepted as proof of eligibility?

A valid NHS identity, Blue Light card, Defence Discount Service card.

VOI 4 ALL

For users from low-income groups, who hold a valid HC2 Certificate Riders who hold a valid HC2 certificate can subscribe to our monthly and daily Voi passes at a discounted price (75%).

What is accepted as proof of eligibility?

A valid HC2 certificate. You can find more information about HC2 certificates <u>here.</u>
Unfortunately, we cannot accept universal credits.

VOI 4 STUDENTS

This discount is for all students and staff at all our higher educational institutes, it enables you to subscribe to our monthly and daily Voi passes at a discounted price (20%)

What is accepted as proof of eligibility?

A valid campus identity card (students or staff) for a UK based higher education institute.

How does it work?

- 1. Create your Voi account through our app.
- Apply for your discount through <u>this application</u> (you will need to upload evidence of your eligibility).
- Wait for a confirmation email from us.

4. Once you have received your confirmation, the discounts as stated above will apply. Standard pricing is applied until you have received that confirmation. Retroactive discounts will not be applied.



Note: that these discounts are not applicable to regular "pay as you go" rides.
