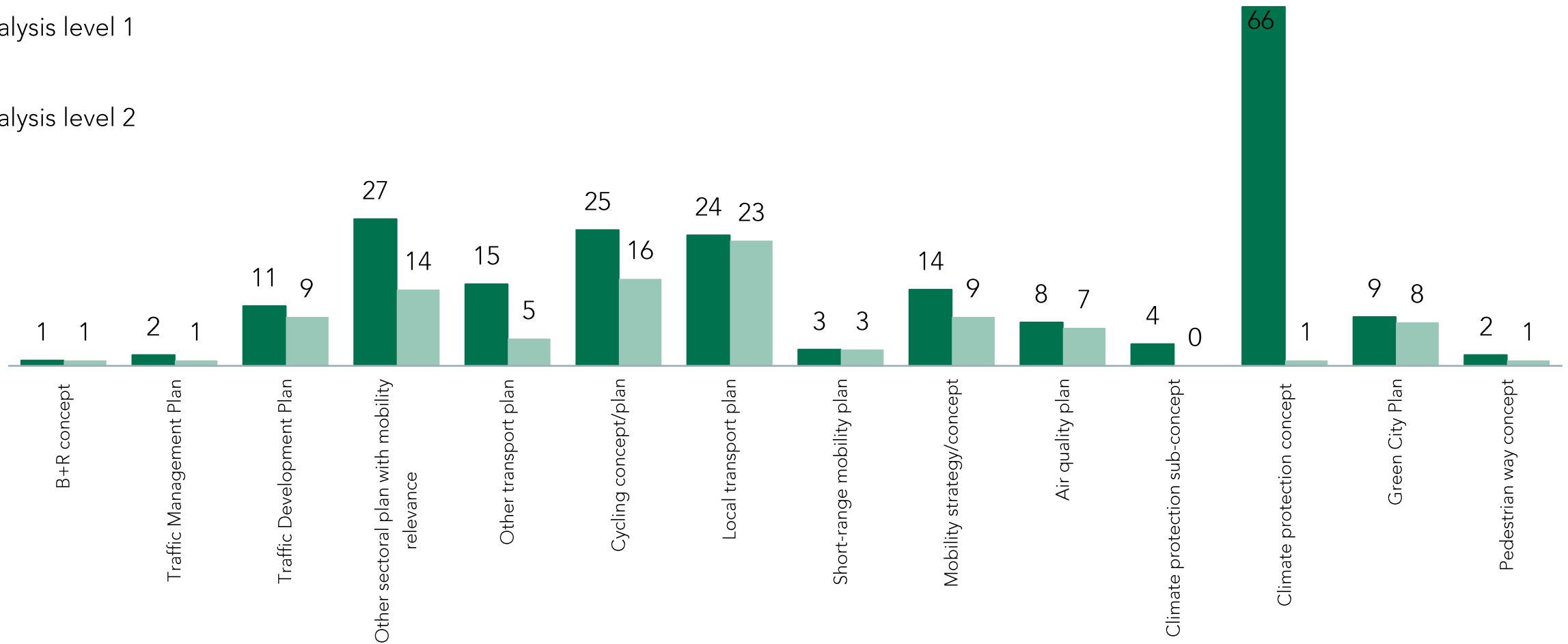

# Mobility Plans in Hesse

## Findings

### synopsis of content



- variation of content:
  - implementation aspects
  - planning phases
- monitoring and evaluation is not a common practice
- pull measures > push measures
- smaller cities focus on accessibility aspects of larger cities
- integrational aspects are not common
- lack of strategical formulations

### Methodological synopsis



- limited financial and personnel capacities
- public participation is common
- interdisciplinary mobility planning is a challenge
- implementation of measures is hard due to a lack of funding
- evaluation and monitoring is not common

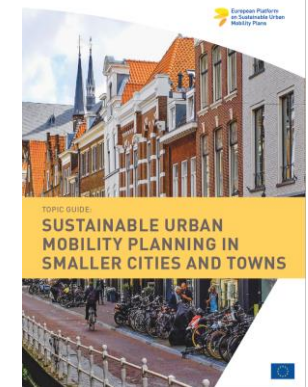
