Example - Agile redesign of a street

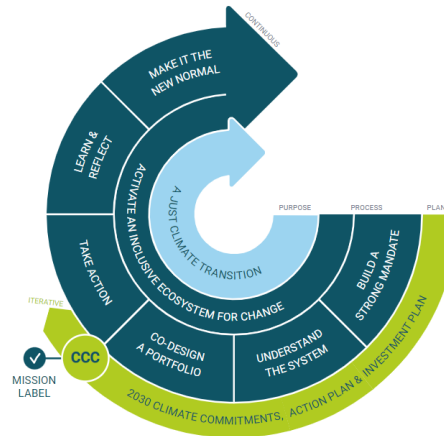

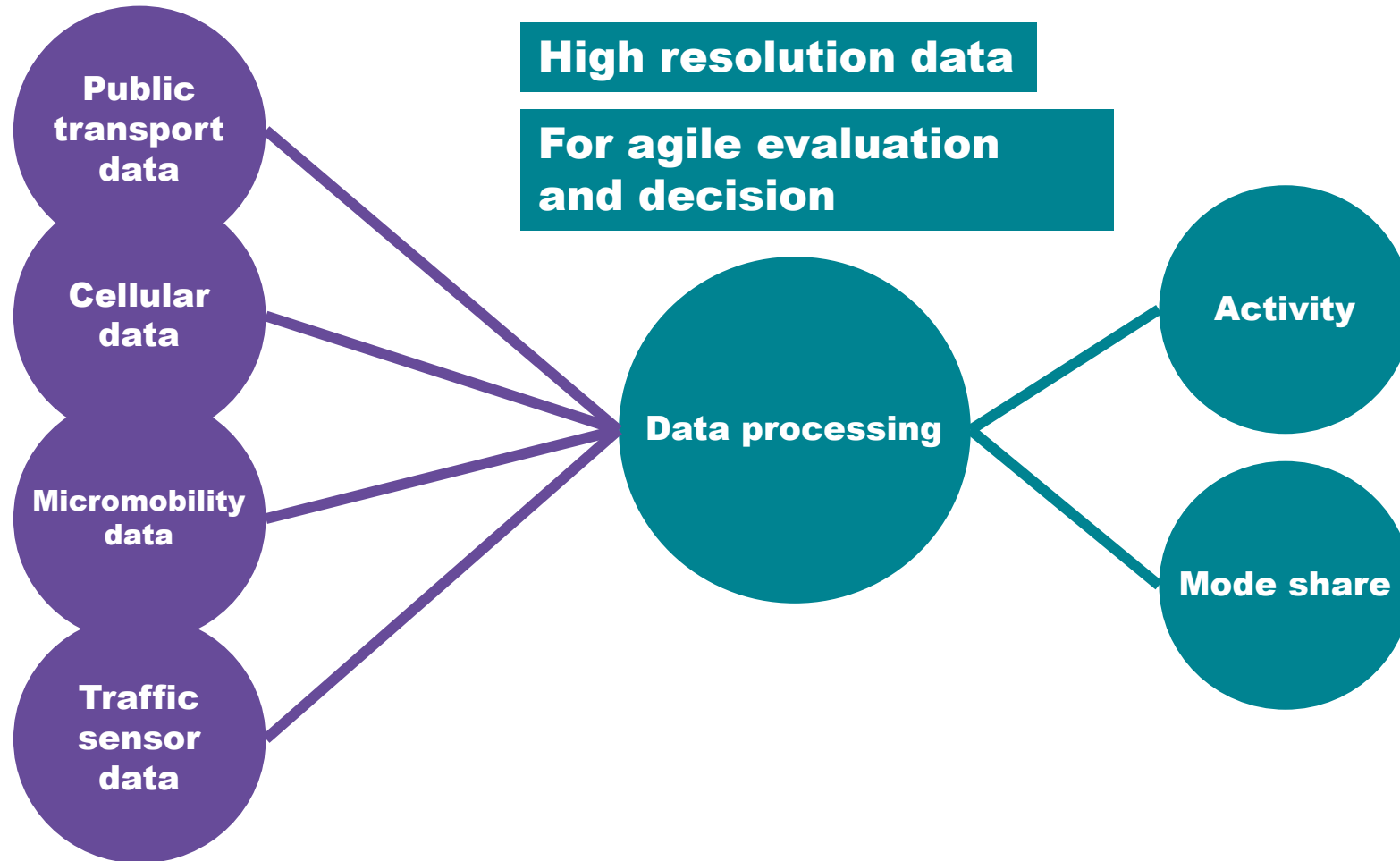

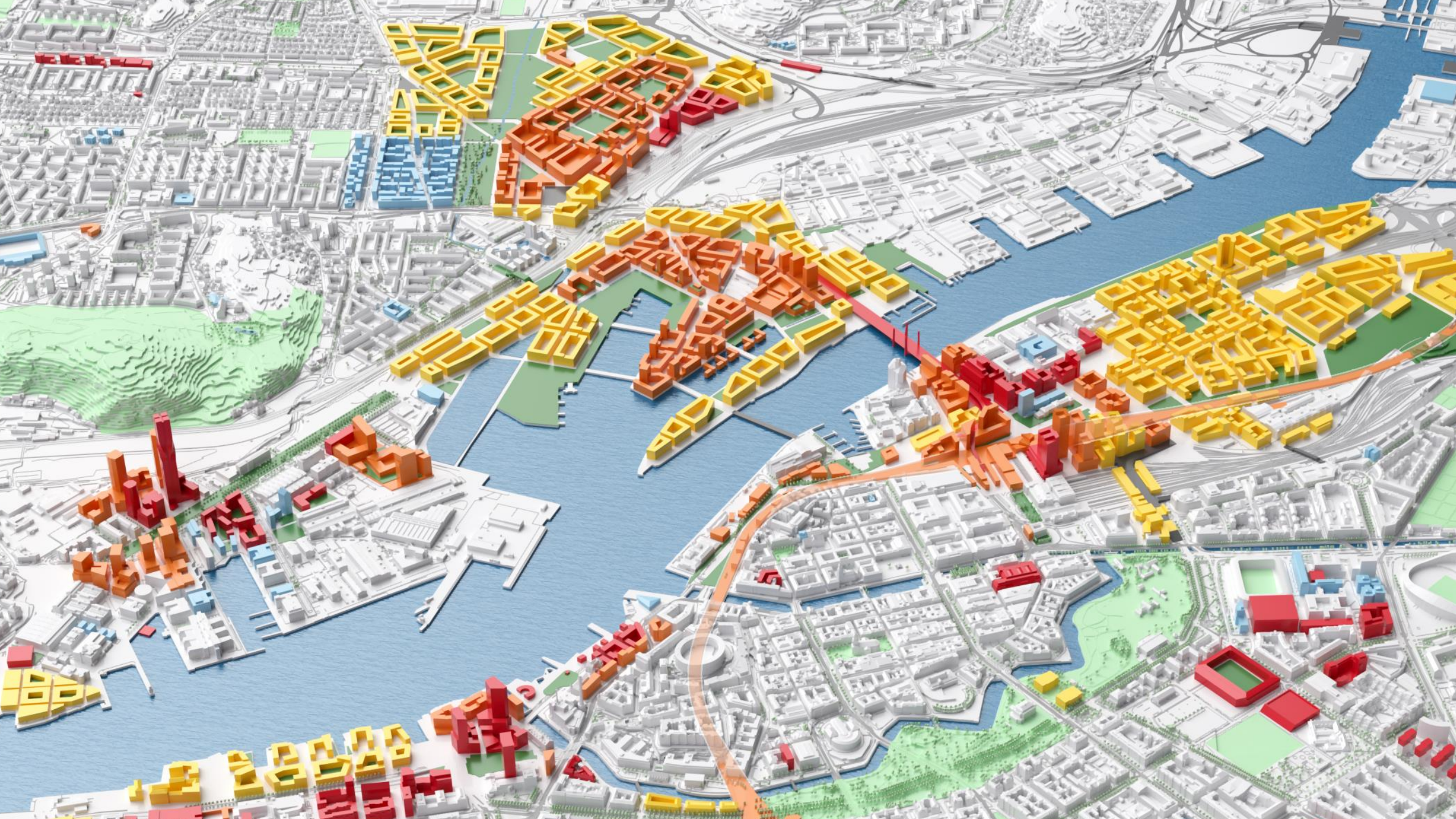
