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Boosting the development of a large-scale European drone market.

Drones will become part of everyday life, with the following services available to EU citizens by 2030:

1. Emergency services, mapping, imaging, inspection, surveillance, and the urgent delivery of medicines or biological samples.
2. Transport services for passengers (Innovative Air Mobility), initially with a pilot on board, but with the ultimate aim of fully automated operations.

With the right framework in place, Europe's drone services market could by 2030 be worth €14.5 billion, and create 145 000 jobs

Flagship action 4

- The Commission intends to adopt rules for the ‘certified’ category of drone operations, addressing the initial and continued airworthiness of drones subject to certification; and the operational requirements applicable to manned VTOL-capable aircraft,

Flagship action 5

- The Commission intends to adopt rules for the design and operations of vertiports under the scope of the EASA Basic Regulation,

Flagship action 7

- The Commission will fund the creation of an online platform to support a sustainable IAM implementation by authorities, communities, municipalities, industry and stakeholders.



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
