

POLIS Membership conditions

General

Membership shall be granted upon approval by the POLIS Management Committee. All requests for membership can be sought by written application to the POLIS Secretariat in Brussels. The written application must be made on a standard application form from the local authority.

Cognisant of the Terms of Reference (Statutes) and the Internal Rules of POLIS, as well as of the scale of membership subscription for the year of commencement of membership, copies of which have been provided, the POLIS Membership applicant commits to complying with the provisions of the Statutes and Internal Rules of POLIS and other decisions taken by the General Assembly, to contribute to the activities of the association and to acquit payment of the yearly membership fees. The membership fee is due within 4 months from the date of sending the invoice.

Membership is based on the calendar year (1 January – 31 December). Fees are applied as follows:

1. Membership starting January to June

Members joining between 1 January and 30 June will pay the full membership fee for the current calendar year.

2. Membership starting July to December

Members joining between 1 July and 31 December will pay 50% of the membership fee for the current calendar year. These members will be invoiced for the full membership fee for the following calendar year.

Members are free to **resign** from the Association **by giving written notice** via special means of communication, **at the latest by 30 September of each year**, to the Secretary General. The resignation shall be effective on 31 December of the year during which the written notice has been sent. As of 1 January 2026, as voted by the POLIS General Assembly in November 2025, yearly fees will be indexed on the basis of the Belgian yearly indexation.

Full membership

Full membership is open to European cities, regions, local and regional transport authorities with a democratically elected government, and related local or regional publicly owned legal entities having the character of a local authority.

Associate membership

Associate Membership is open to entities which are not eligible for full membership such as non-European cities and regions, associations, research centres and universities with an interest in local and regional transport. Associate members do not take part in the POLIS internal decision-making process and do not vote at the General Assembly.
