





STF – PA TF5: Objectives

- This is a growing issue and Cities & Regions, CPOs,
 Parking companies need to be ready for deploying
 barrier-free recharging infrastructure. But how?
- AFIR references the charging pole and hardware. But what about the surrounding environment and location?
- We cannot refurbish everything, but it doesn't mean we disregard this topic

STF – PA TF5: State of play

Scope of the guidelines:

- 1. Hardware: pole/charging station: design, new technologies like wireless charging...
- 2. Associated parking spaces and surrounding environment
- 3. Distribution/location of accessible recharging poles/stations & parking spaces (ratio of accessible recharging infra)

Key challenges:

- 1. General problems and bottlenecks
- 2. Design of the charging points
- 3. Parking place requirements and surrounding area
- 4. Distribution of accessible recharging stations in urban areas and along TENT-T corridors
