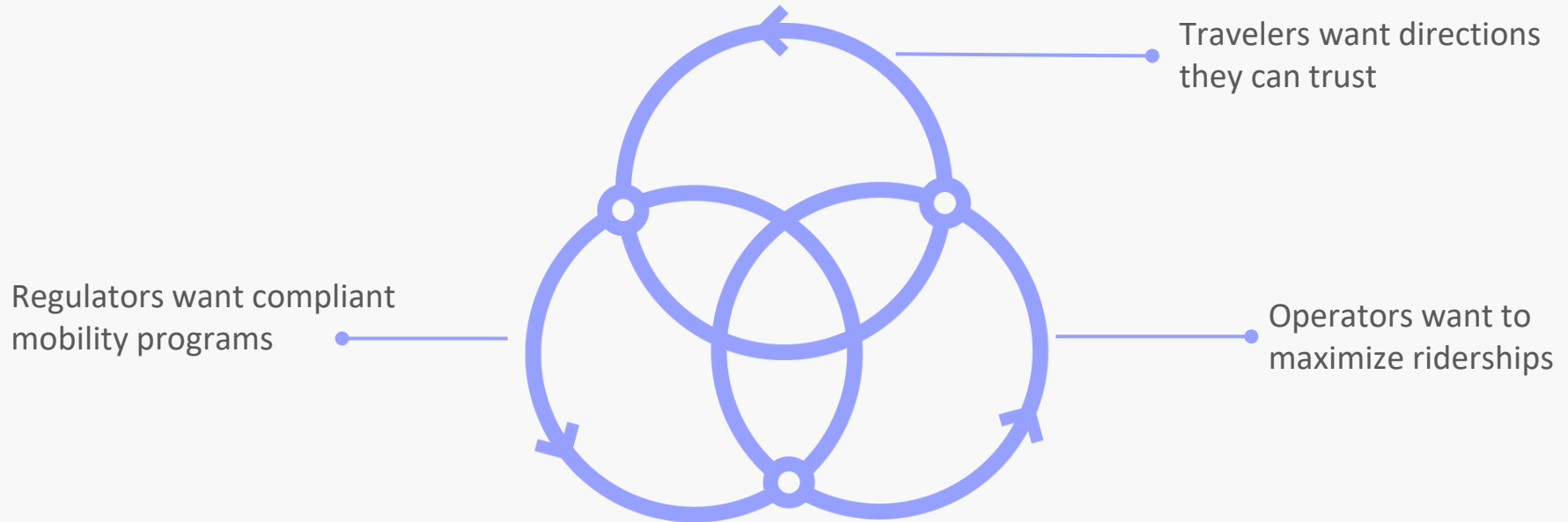

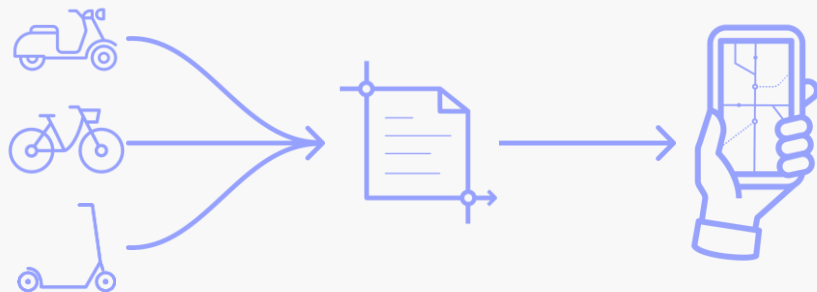

In 2015, GBFS was created by members of the bikeshare industry,  
for the bikeshare industry.

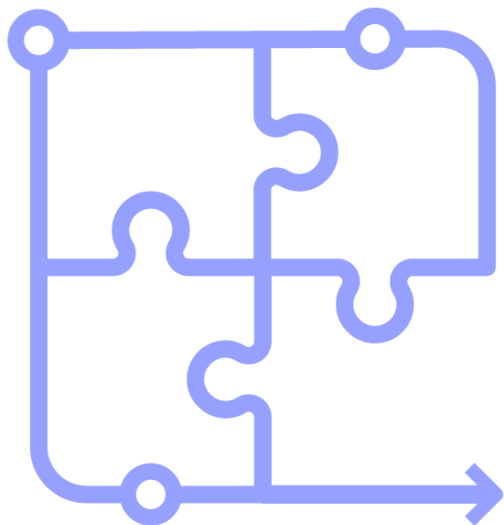
Originally, GBFS allowed us to describe:

- Station and bike locations
- Bike and dock availability
- Basic business rules and information



There are now over 900 GBFS feeds that we know off  
across 44 countries.

Europe accounts for 507 feeds in 29 countries.

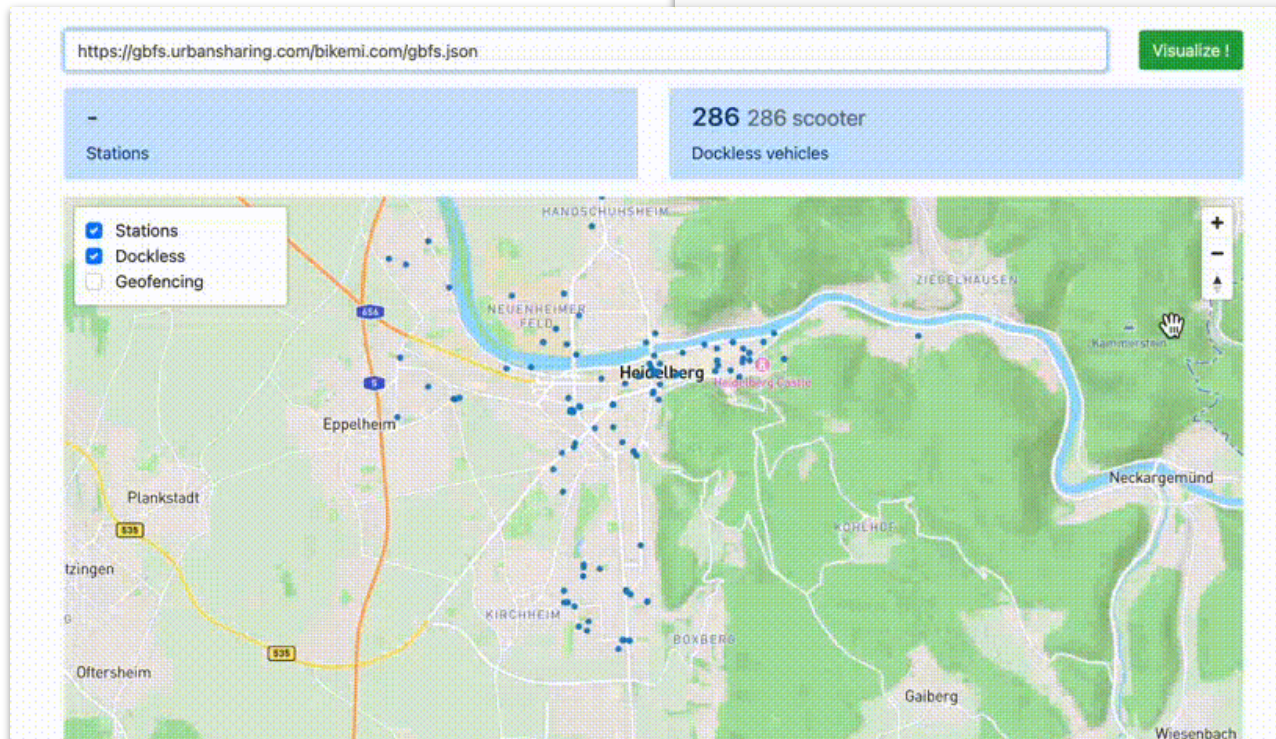
GBFS is a building block for you!

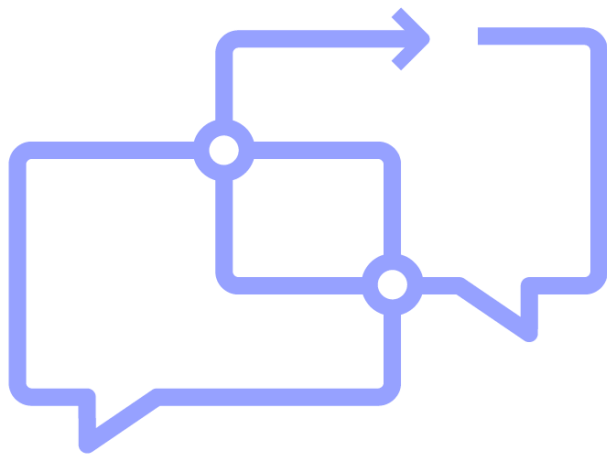

## PARTICIPATION

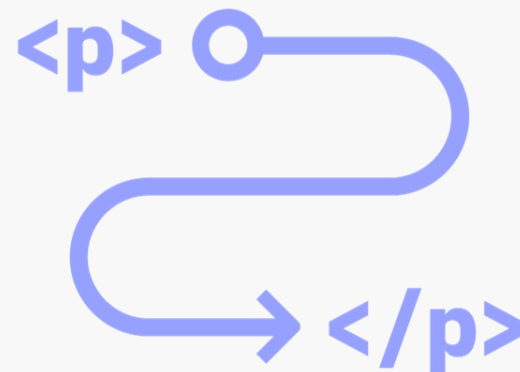
GBFS is a completely open specification
