

Originally, GBFS allowed us to describe:


- → Station and bike locations
- → Bike and dock availability
- → Basic business rules and information





There are now over 900 GBFS feeds that we know off across 44 countries.

Europe accounts for 507 feeds in 29 countries.




BUT WHAT ABOUT CITIES?


GBFS is a completely open specification
