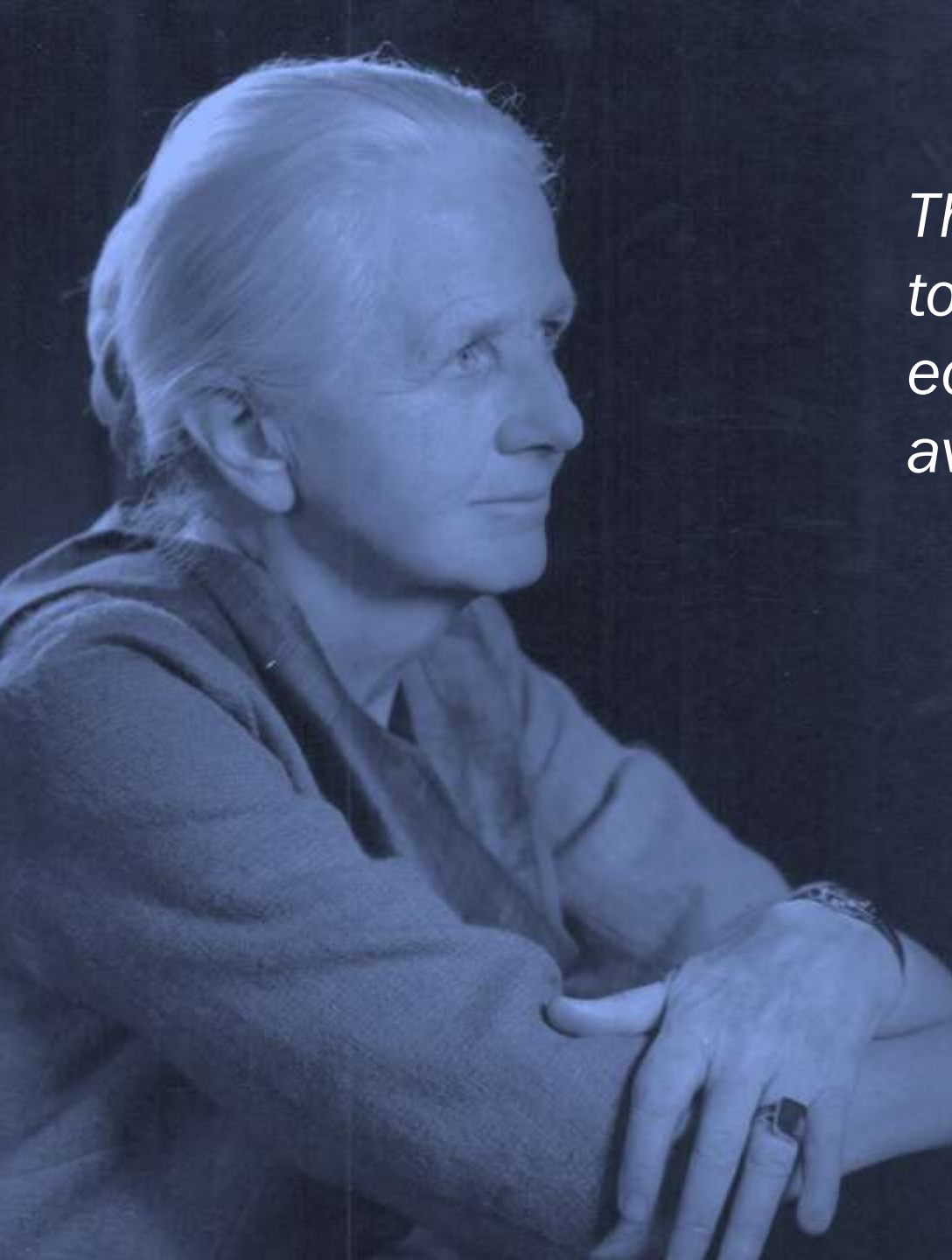

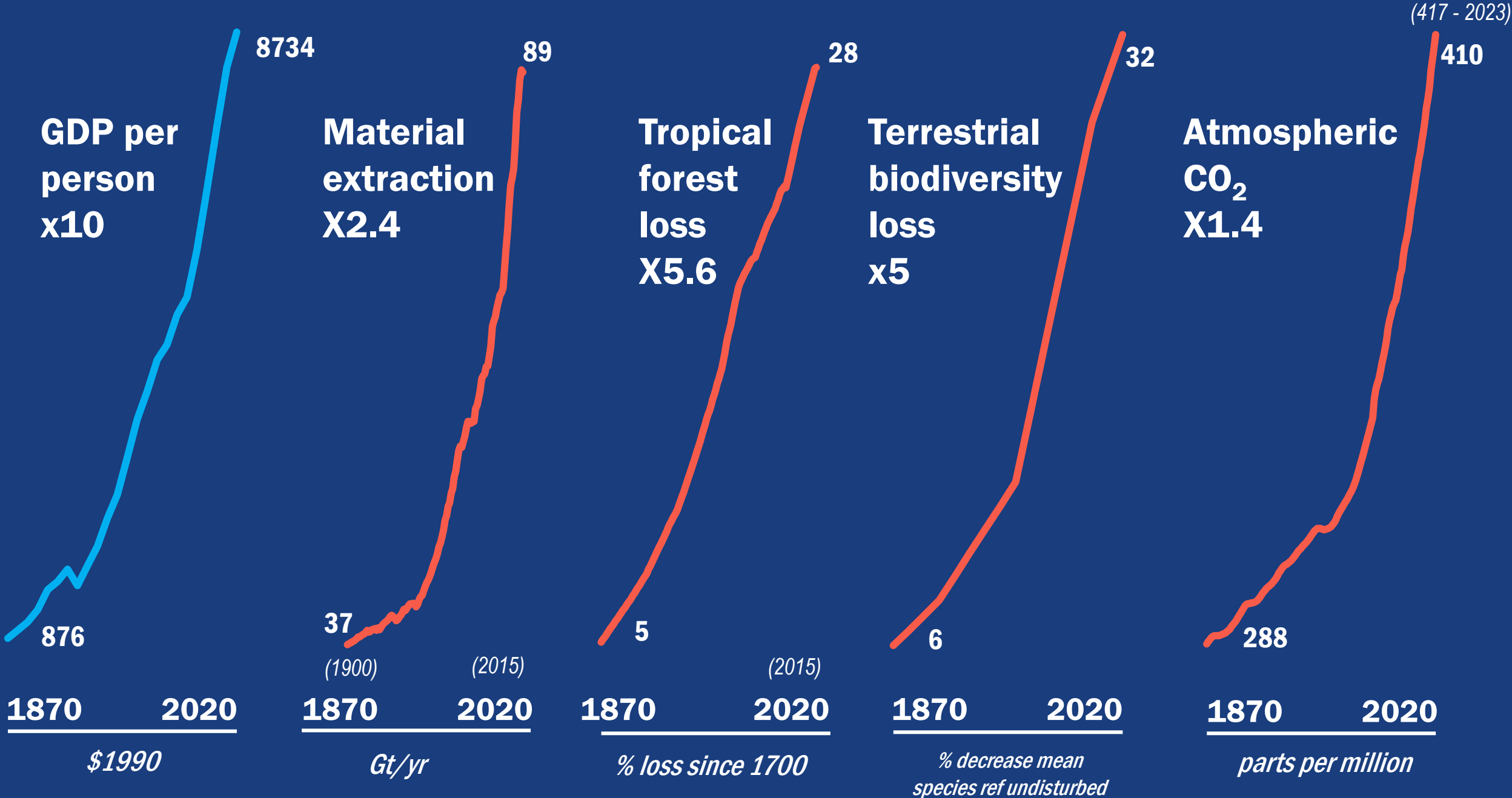

Global average temperature change

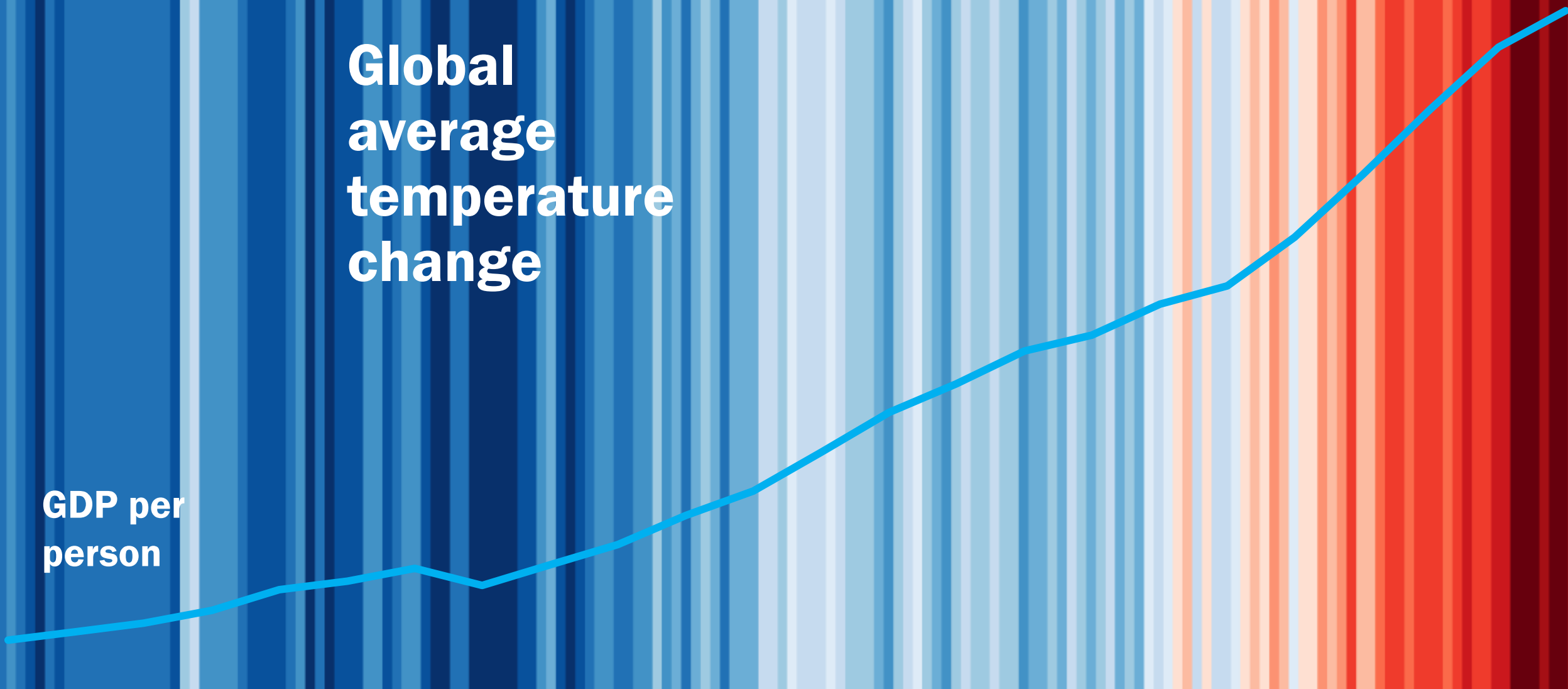
GDP per person

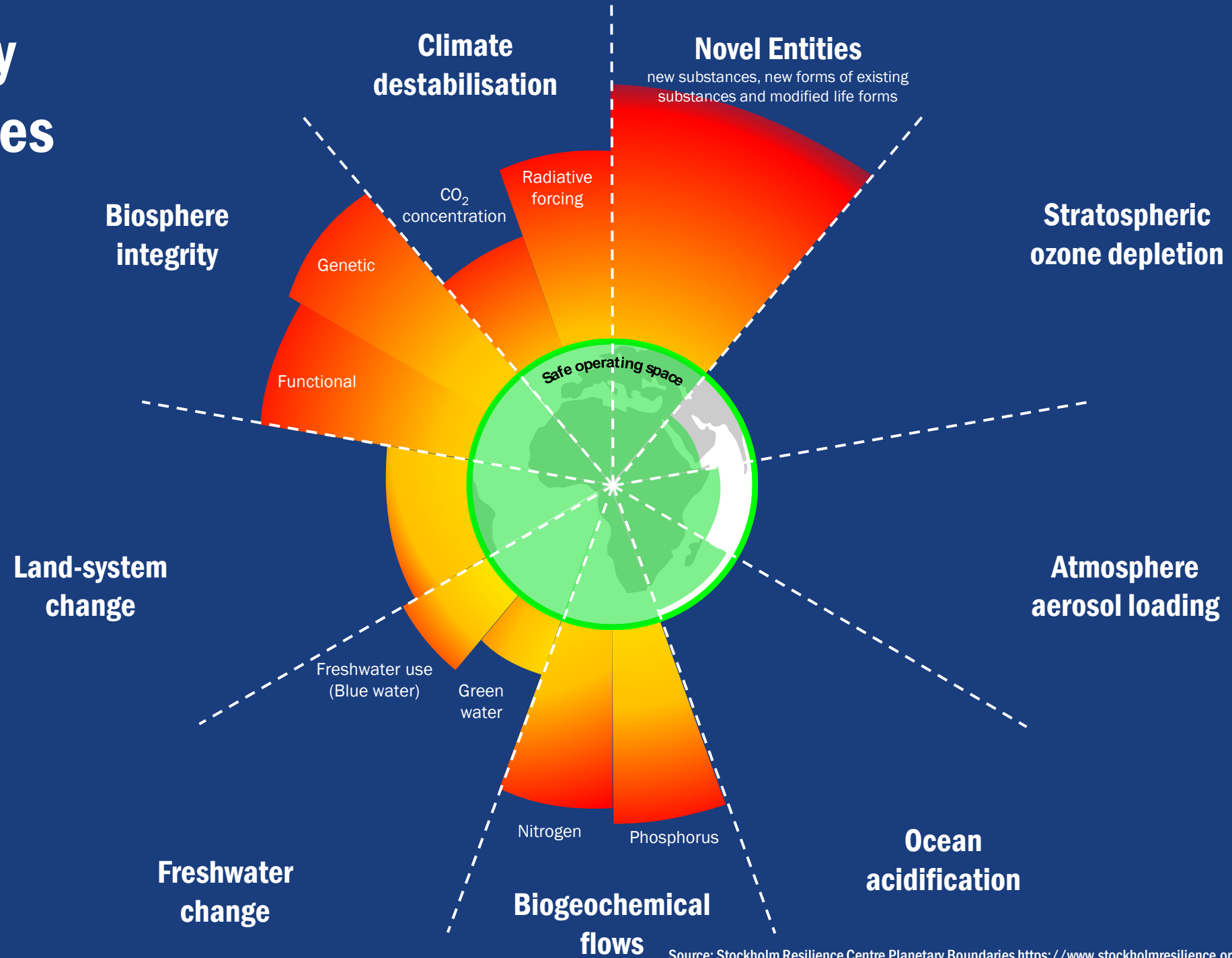

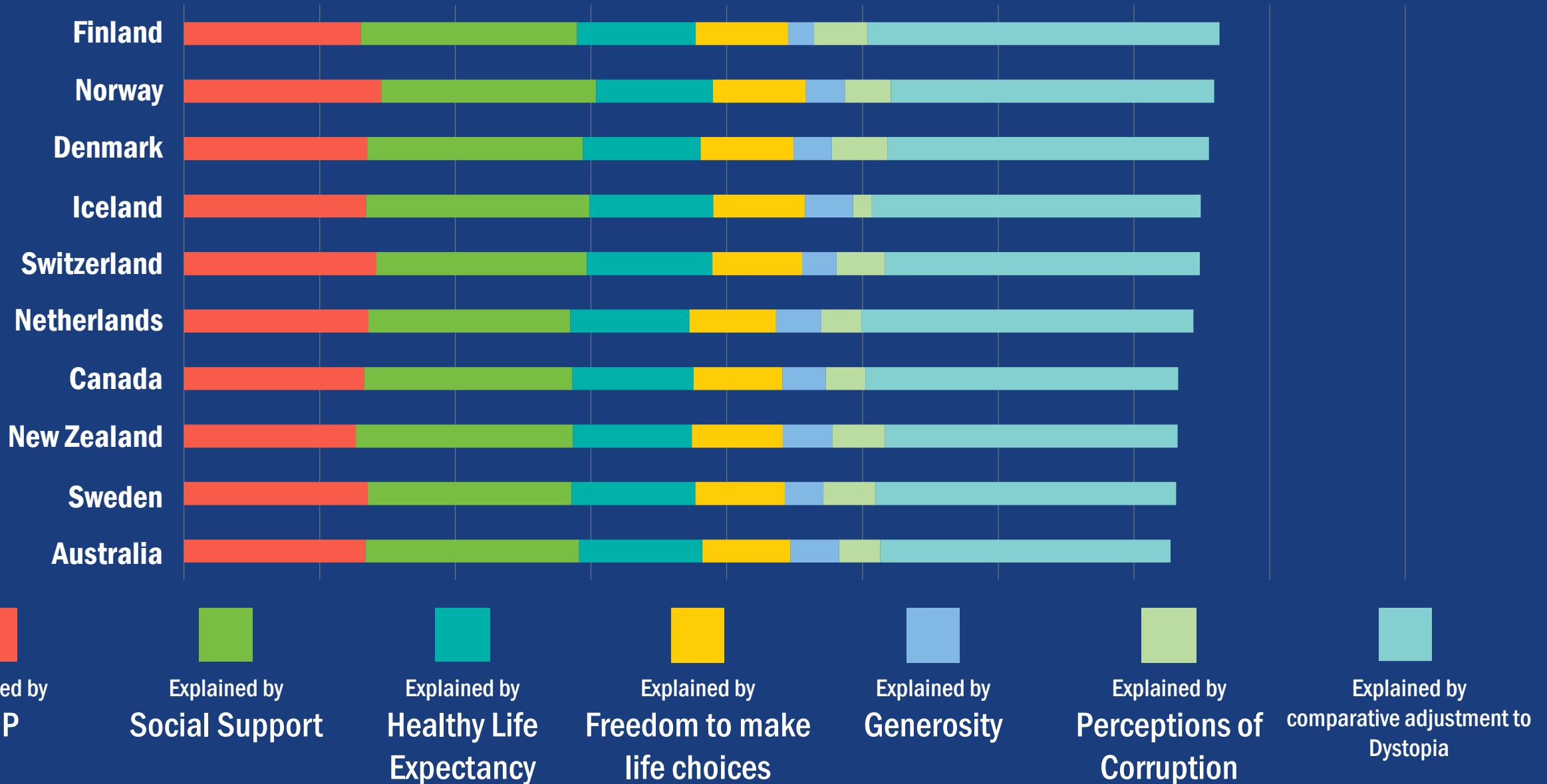

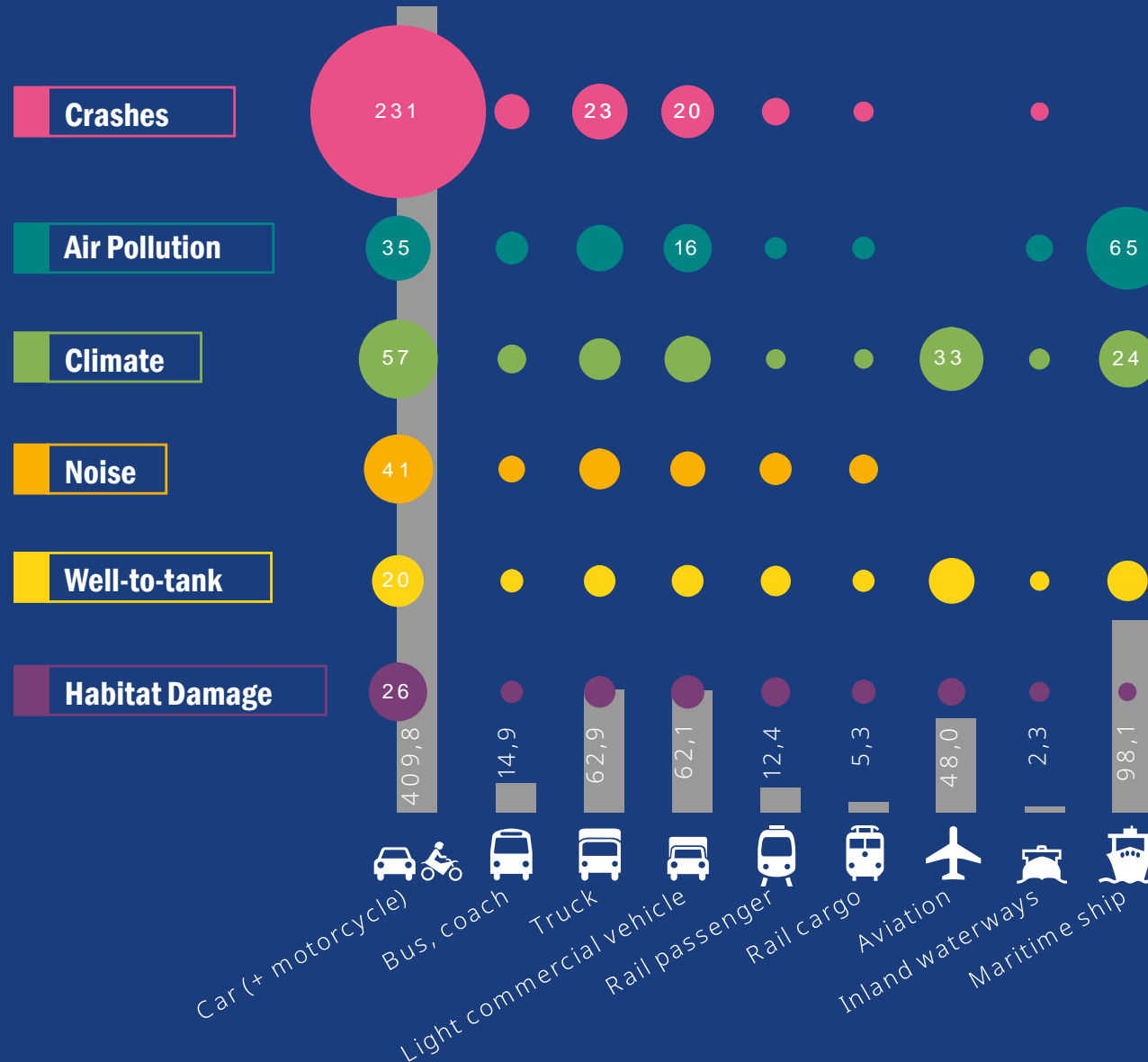


Total external costs of transport in the EU, 2016

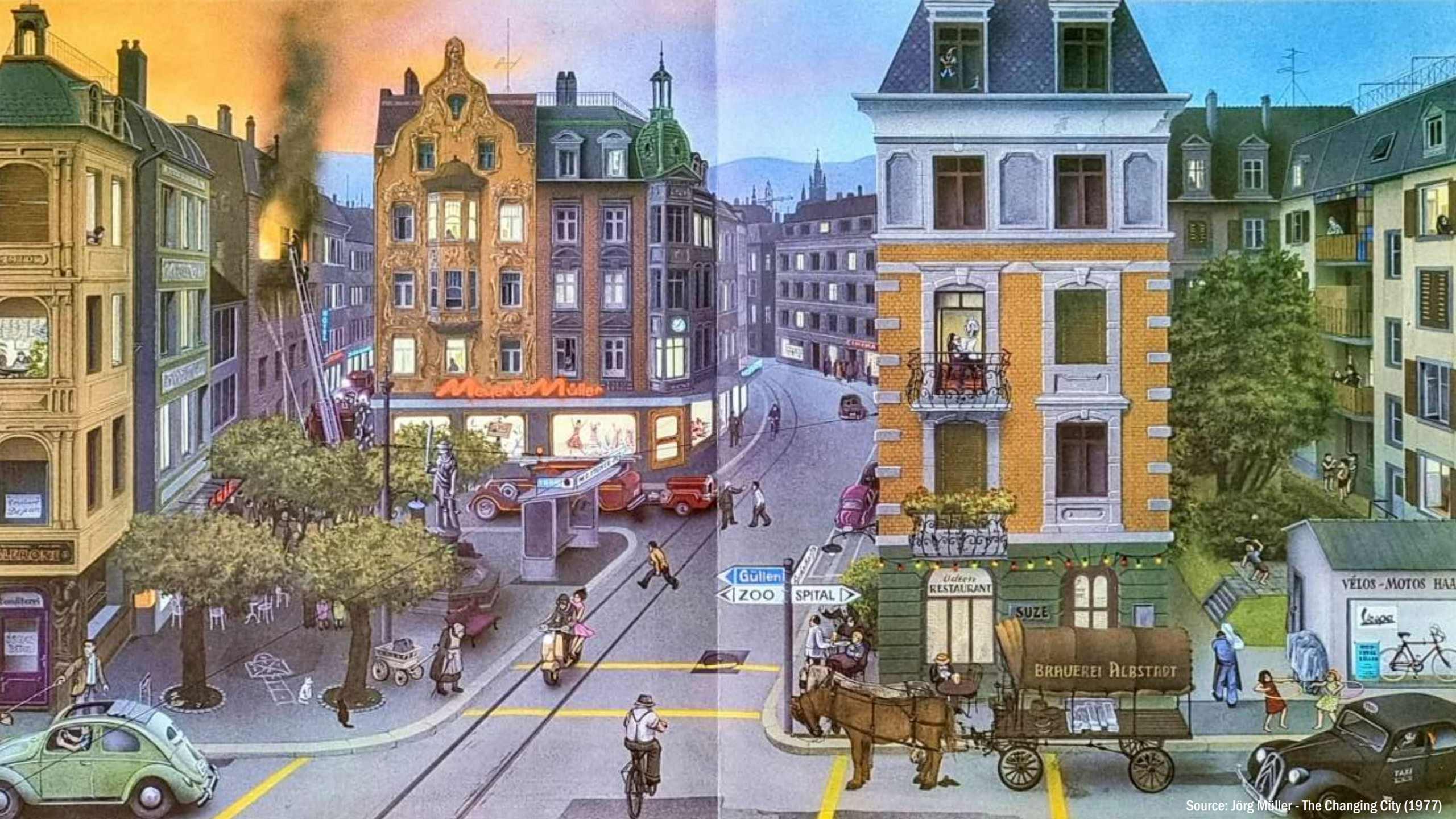
Deploy compensatory measures where needed

Be mindful of economic exclusion and invisibility

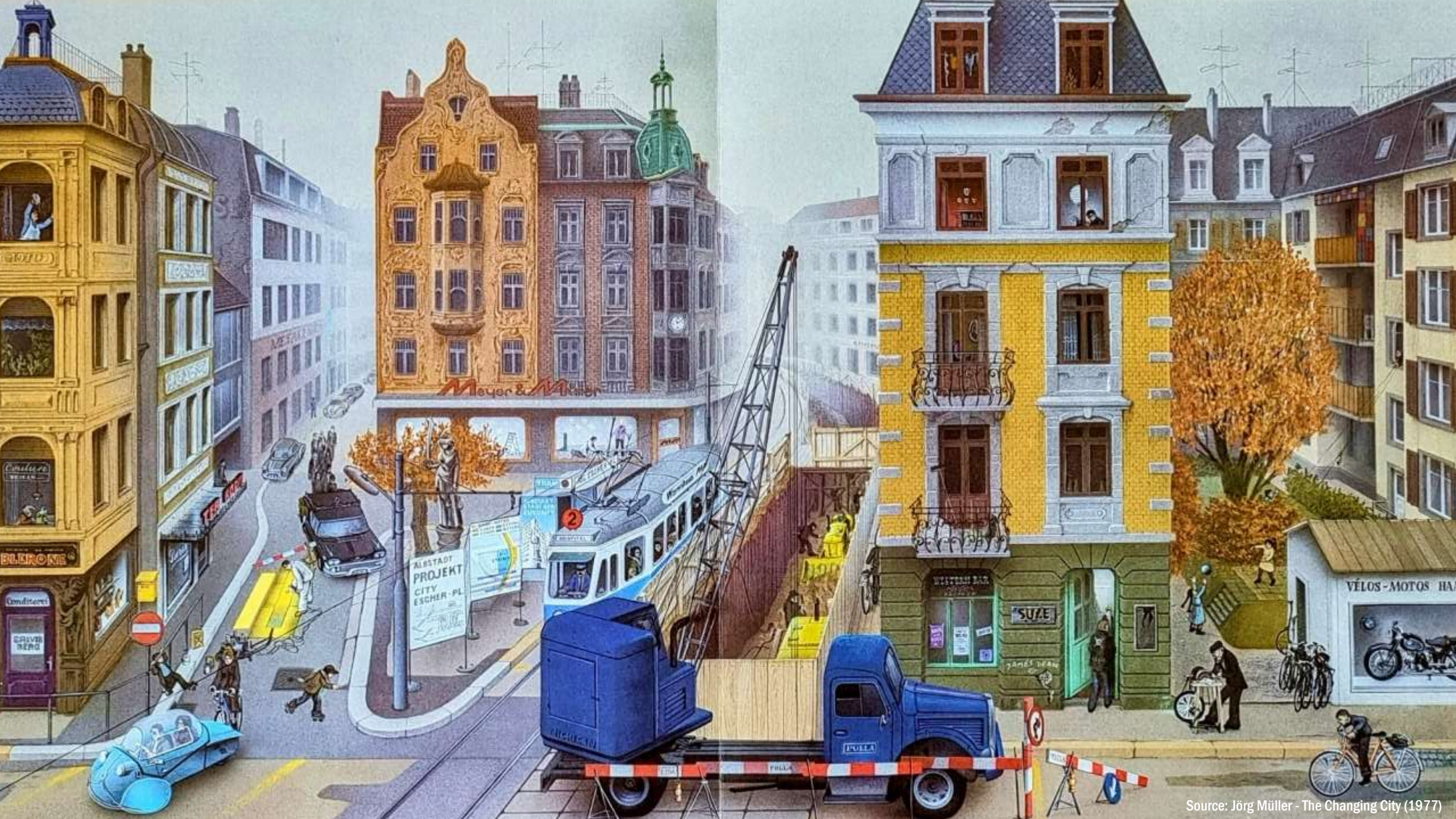

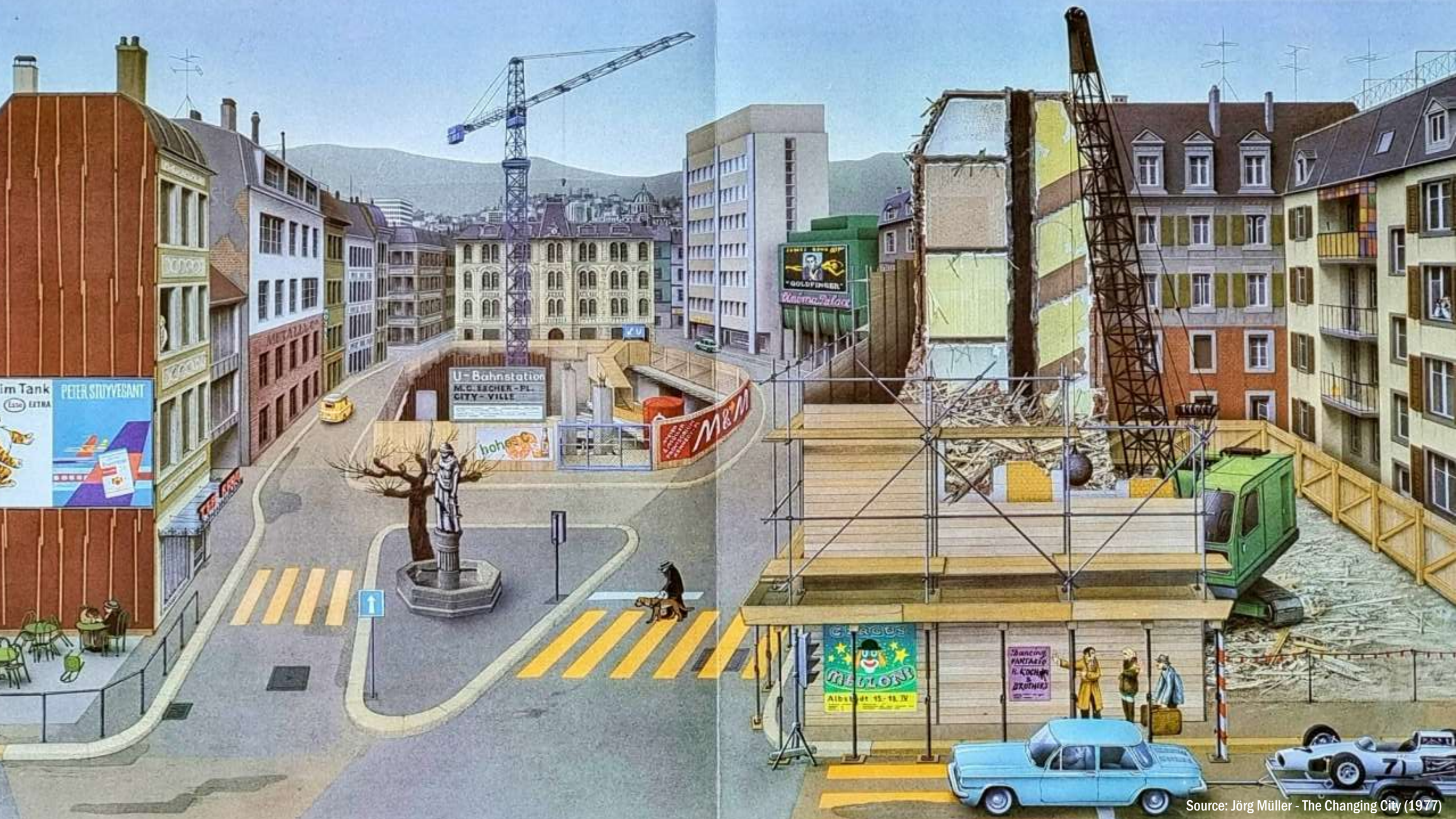
