










# Air quality in the lle-de-France transport network

- **123 stations** with low levels of particle pollution (30%)
- **276 stations** with average levels of particle pollution (67%)
- 13 stations with high levels of particle pollution (3%)









- Reinforcement of ventilation fans
- Replacement of braking systems
- Implementing innovation
- Seize all upcoming opportunities
