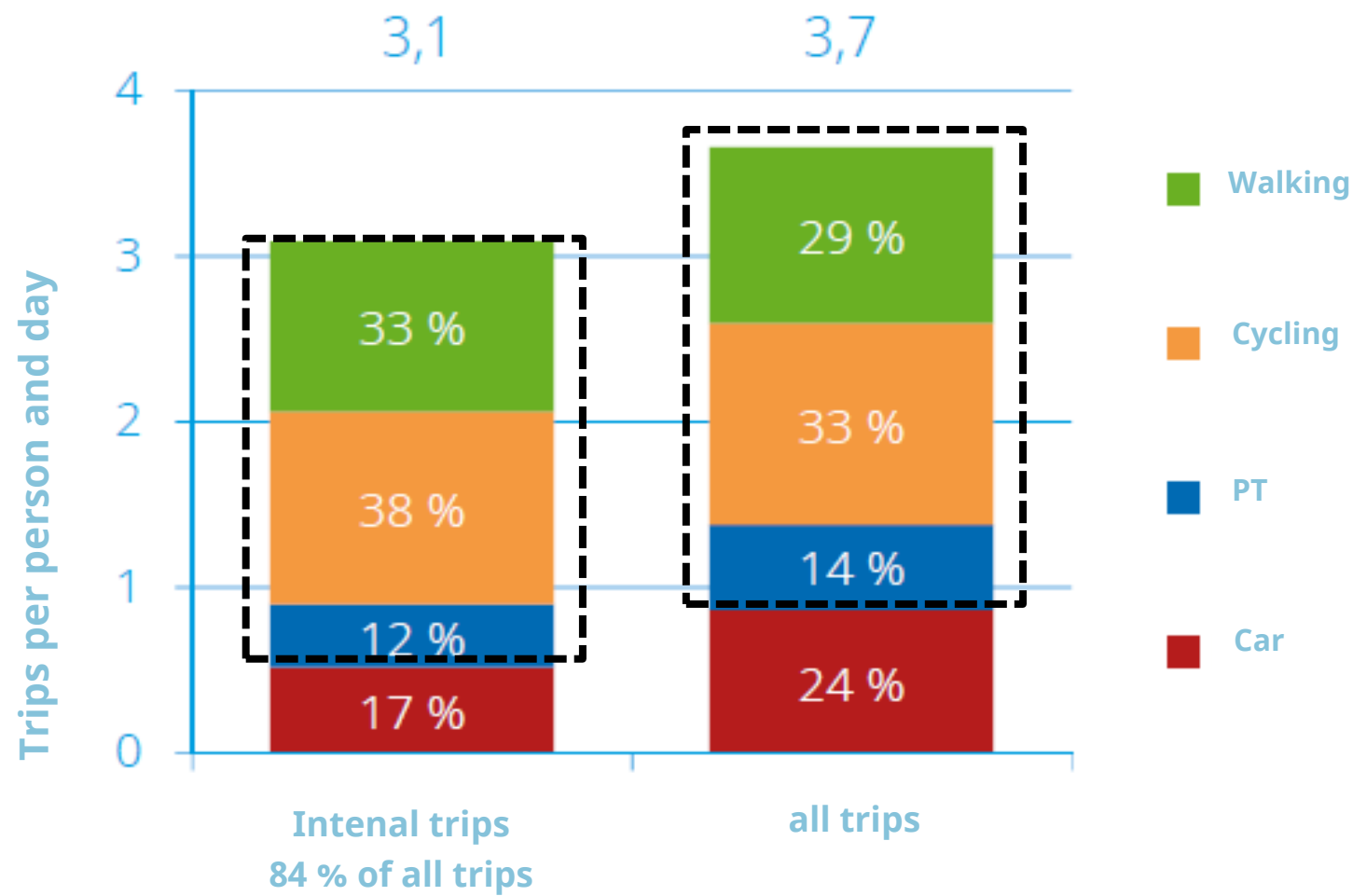

## Transportation mode according to trip volumen (surveyed)

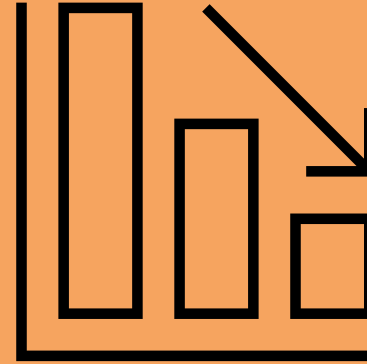

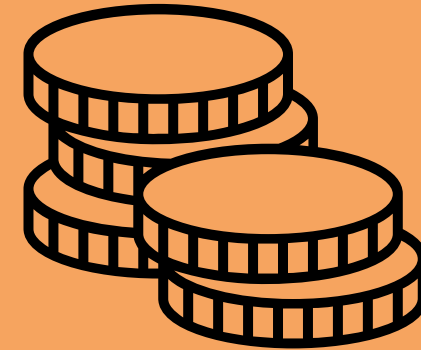


# Framework: Our SUMP is a Climate Mobility Plan

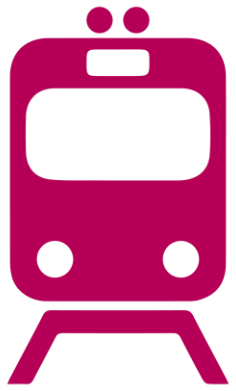

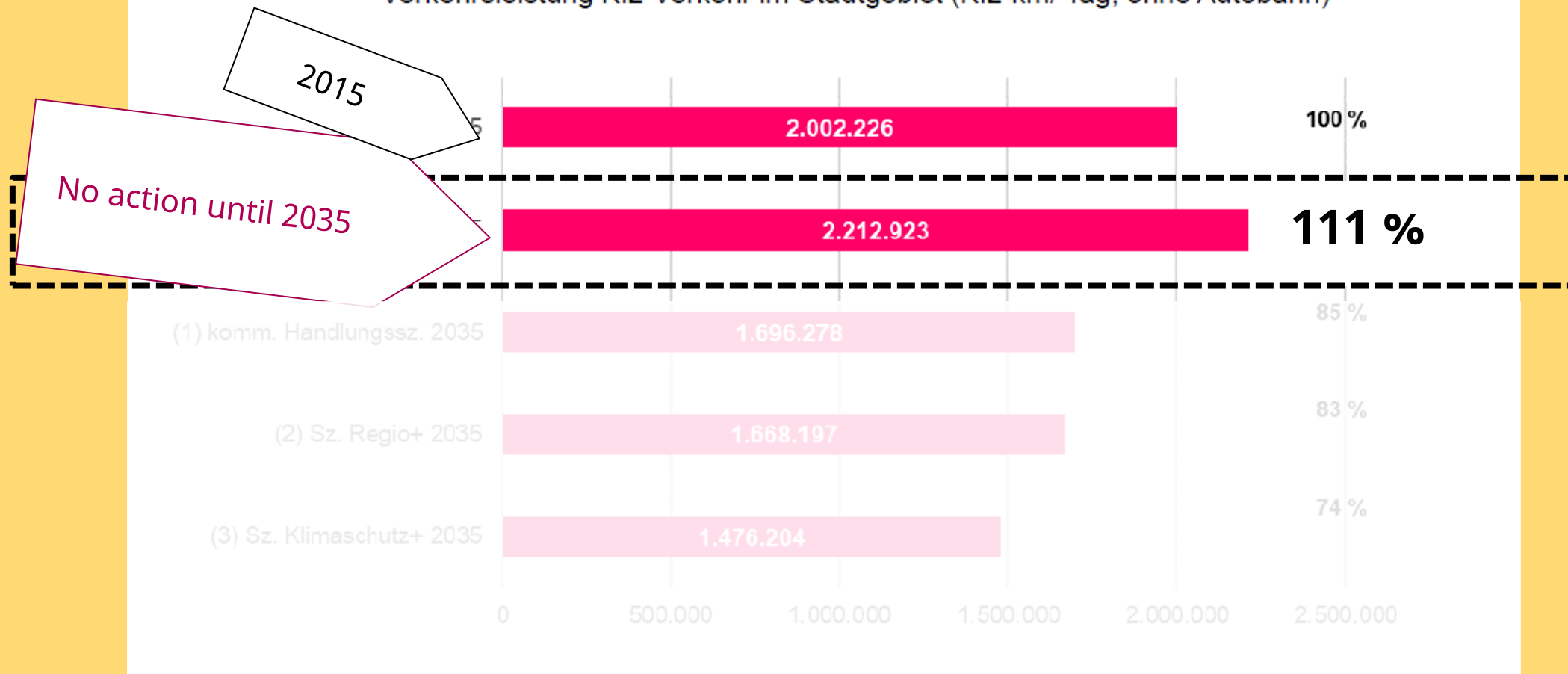

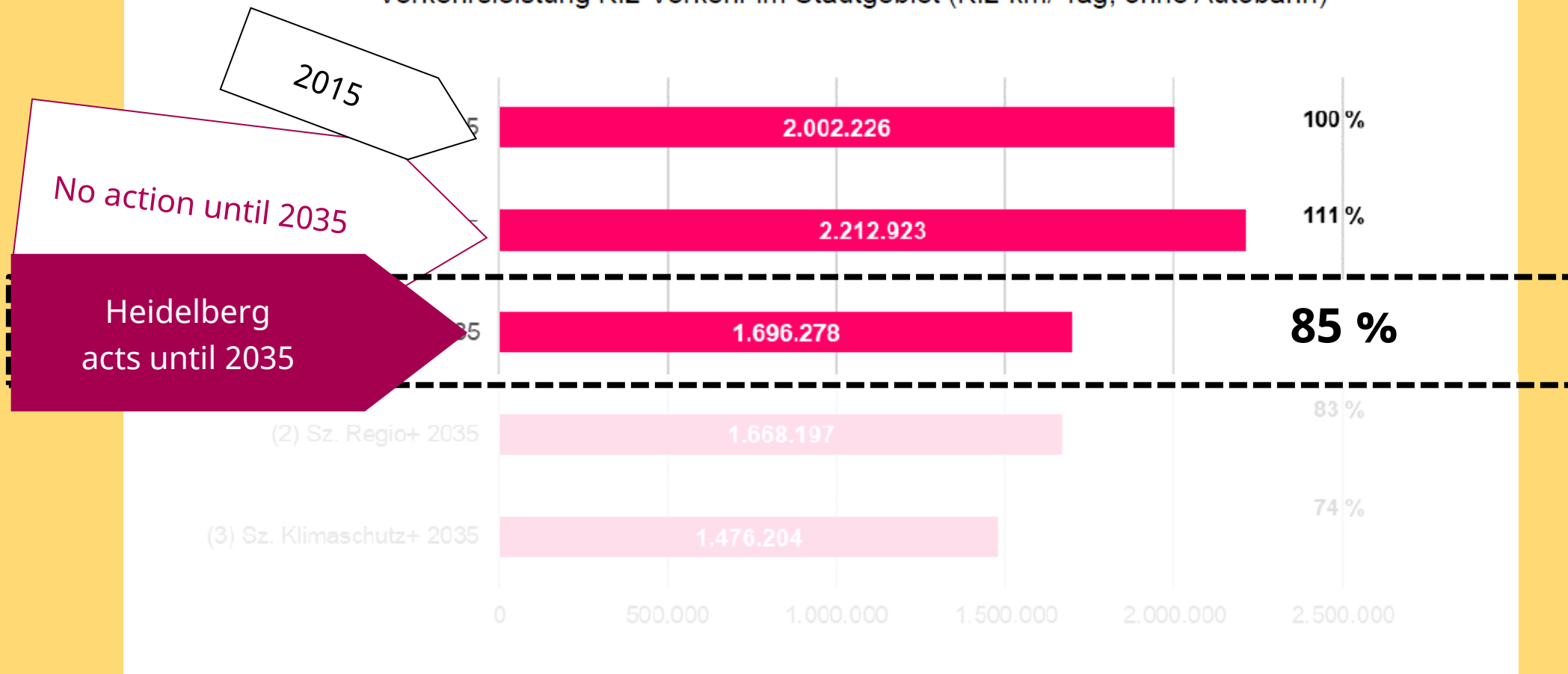
### Verkehrsleistung Kfz-Verkehr im Stadtgebiet (Kfz-km/ Tag, ohne Autobahn)







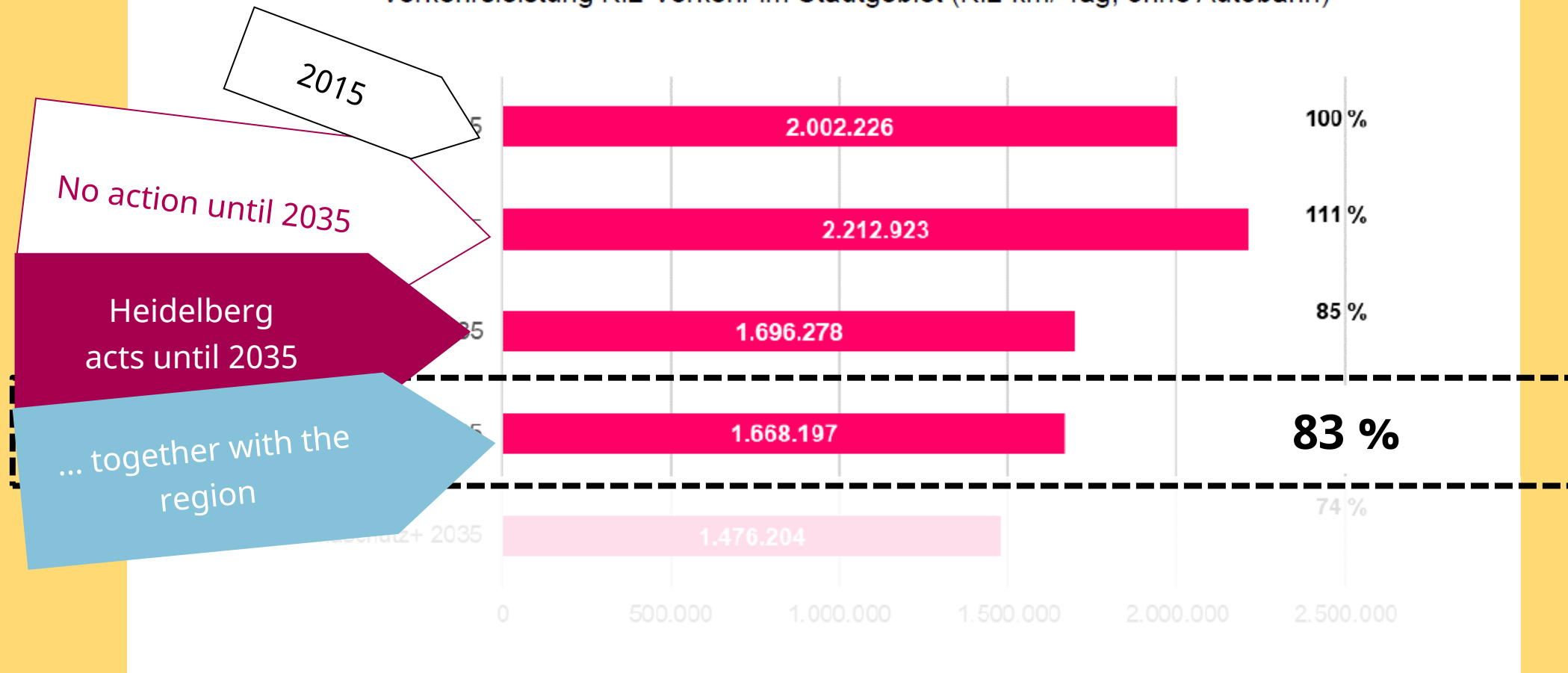
