

SUMP Strategy for the next decade in Rome – 2035 horizon

- Intelligent Transport Systems
- Enhancement of the road network and park-and-ride systems
- New public transport infrastructure and services, including:
 - Extension of **Metro Line C** to Piazzale Clodio
 - Construction of the new **Metro Line D**
 - Extensions of **Metro Lines B, C, A, B1 A1 junction**
 - Upgrading of existing metro lines
 - **11 new tram lines**, 4 of which are already funded
 - Expansion of the **urban rail system**
 - Additional infrastructure for local public transport
- **BICIPLAN**: cycling network extension, sharing mobility
- **Pedestrian Mobility Plan**: 77 environmental zones and urban renewal projects
- Mobility Management with companies, incentives for PT
- Renewal of the public transport fleet with LEV and ZEV
- Incentives and infrastructure for electric mobility
- Implementation of the **SULP** (Strategic Urban Logistics Plan)
- Implementation of the Plan for Road Safety (Vision Zero)






BUS PLAN for the JUBILEE of YOUTH

180 km of parking for buses

- Dedicated application to purchase parking tickets
- Development of the parking plan was developed tourist buses, with a total of **9,000 spaces** identified.

Approximately half are "**proximity**" (requiring continued travel to the event area **on foot**) and the other half are "**remote**" (requiring continued travel to the event area using **local public transportation**).





WELCOMING PILGRIMS IN SCHOOLS AND EXTRACURRICULAR SITES




Around **100,000** pilgrims were hosted in schools, sports centres and extracurricular sites and in city's parishes



Rome among the **100 EU cities towards climate neutrality EU MISSION LABEL** gained in 2025



From the Car-Centric to the Intermodal approach

PULLing people towards TPL and sustainable modes:

- New MRT lines, new depots
- Renewal of PT fleet
- Urban space redistribution (cycling, 30 zones, etc.)
- Multimodal hubs
- MaaS, network management and planning with real time data
- Incentives and LPT/sharing integration

PUSHing people away from the private vehicles:

- Limited Traffic Zones
- Congestion Charge
- Low Emission Zone (Green Area)

Rome's Mobility: Results achieved



Infrastructures & Areas

- Metro stations & equipment maintenance
- Tram depot upgrades (1 new, 1 upgraded)
- New peripheral tourist bus parking
- New pedestrian & green areas



Soft & Active Mobility

- New pedestrian routes (historical areas)
- Key Cycleways: GRAB & Rome-Fiumicino
- Cycleway Monte Ciocci-S. Pietro
- Road Safety: Blackpoint interventions



PT Procurement (WIP)

- 480 New "smart" bus stops
- 843 New Buses (411 Electric, 322 CNG, 110 Hybrid)
- 14 New Metro trains
- 121 New Tram convoys

- **EU Mission Label:** "100 Climate-Neutral & Smart Cities"
- **Glydeways Award:** Recognizing urban innovation
- **Urban Award 2025:** Excellence in Sharing Mobility

Lessons Learnt & Strategic Outlook

Cities host 75% of EU citizens and are crucial to achieve European Global Goals.

Capitals, thanks to their visibility, scale, and influence should be examples for other cities in promoting sustainable and climate-neutral transport.

- Rome promoted the setup of a Group of Capital Cities within POLIS network to report the EU Commission the need to adapt the TEN-T regulation, Governance and funding mechanism for such "special cities"
- Capitals require to secure funding for "special" expense related to their unique nature.
- The Jubilee organisation proved the **effectiveness of multi-level collaboration** (Rome administration, National Government, Region, Holy See, Unions, Police, PTO and utilities etc.)
