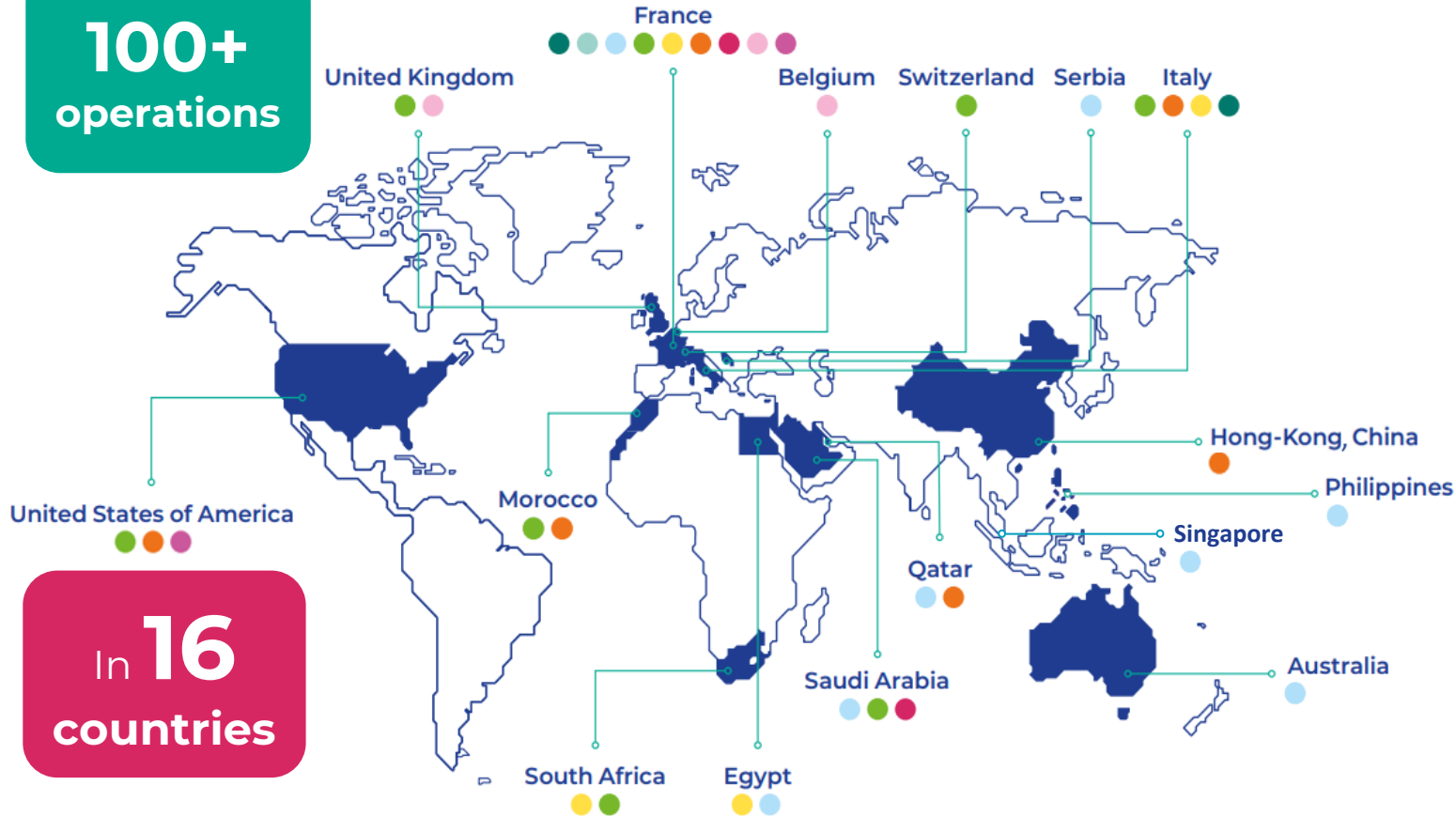

Greener deliveries in the heart of the city by facilitating last mile delivery



- **Smart use of space:** share underused bus depots during the day for cross-docking, without major investment
- **Low-emission delivery:** clean fleets (electric vans, cargo bikes), reducing GHG emissions by up to 80%
- **Circular urbanism & chronotopy:** circular urbanism and time-sharing to intensify site use and reduce urban sprawl
- **Better urban living:** less noise, traffic, and emissions, improving quality of life in dense neighborhoods

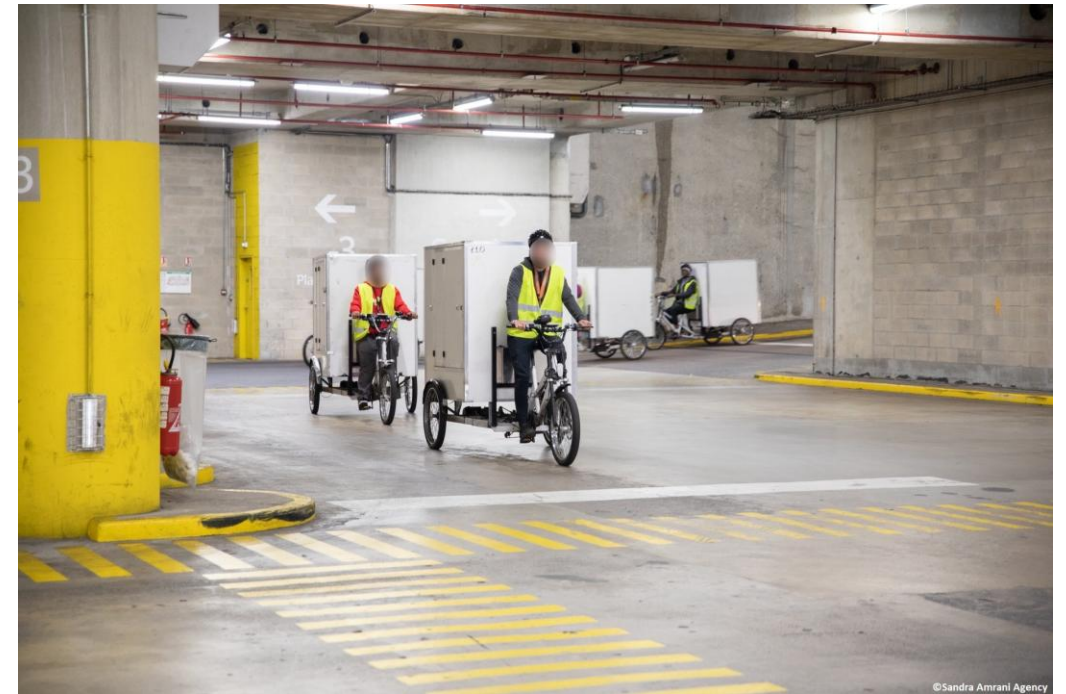
Our commitment to a more responsible city

Optimising our assets and facilitating last mile logistics in the city

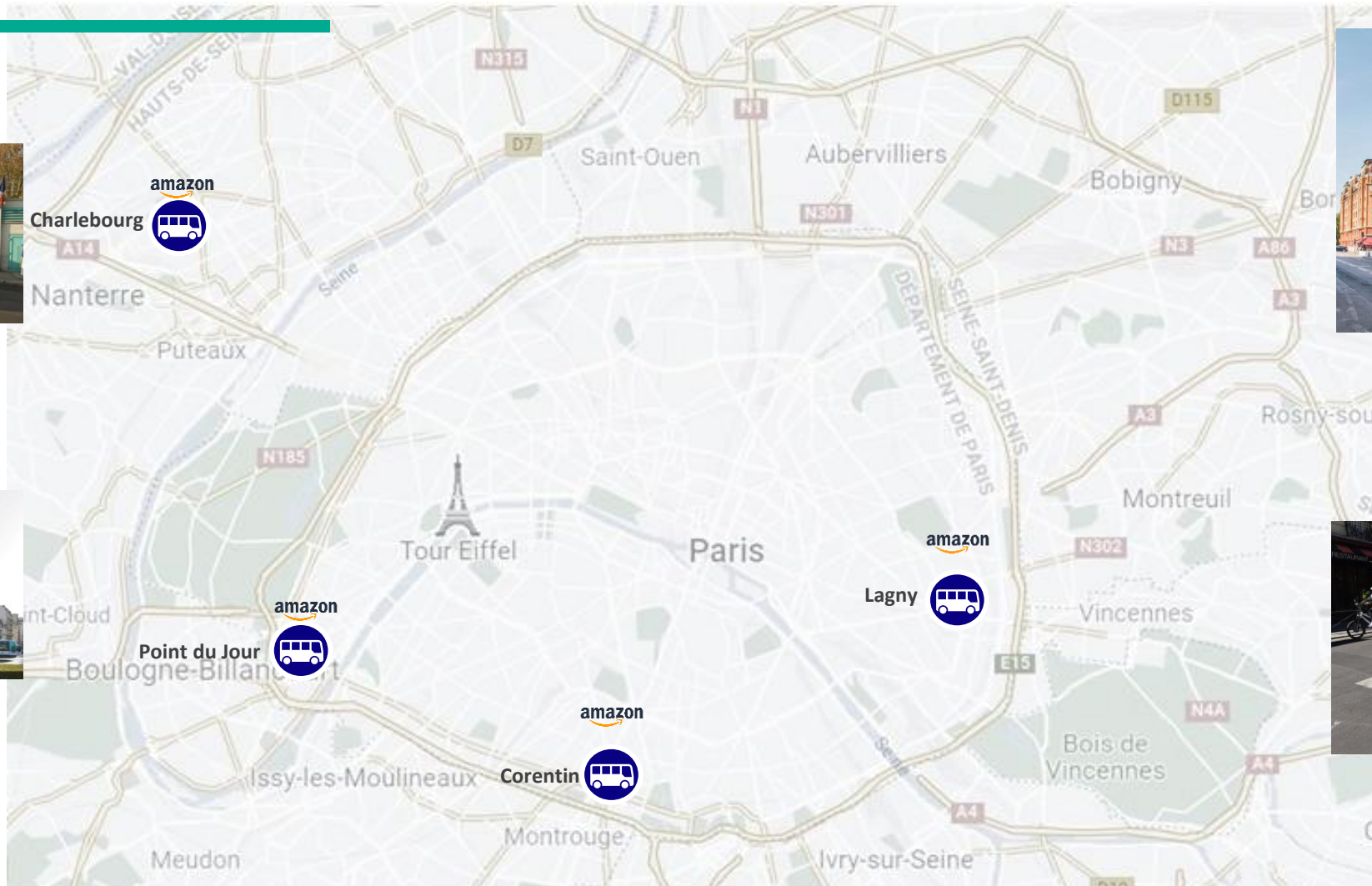
With its **RATP Logistics** offer, RATP Solutions Ville is innovating in industrial ecology and designing the city of tomorrow by offering pragmatic **urban logistics** that take climate issues into account.

Our solution, with the agreement of the Paris region transportation authority, Ile-de-France Mobilités, allows to make use of its assets for the benefit of sustainable cities by promoting **greener deliveries in the heart of the city**, notably by facilitating **last mile** delivery.

Reduction of negative externalities in serviced areas = fewer kilometers traveled, less noise, congestion, and air pollution (*) (-49% fine particles at the exhaust, -80% NOX).
